I, for one, am so glad that we are entering the Spring of the year and things seem to be getting back to normal. It will be so refreshing to be able to gather in person for events and to recreate that sense of community. I am excited to begin the 4th quarter and to celebrate all those traditions that make us uniquely OLSS!

Speaking of tradition, I am excited to announce that we will be reviving an OLSS tradition. Starting next year, we will be returning to our original OLSS uniform, which will highlight our quintessential plaid. Recently, the Catholic Schools Office invited us to showcase our school by posting pictures of our students in their school-specific plaids. This was the catalyst for my decision to return to our roots.

Uniforms for PK and K will not change. The new school uniforms for students in Grades 1-8 will be:

- Boys in Grades 1-8: Light blue polo or button-down shirt with navy shorts or pants.
- **Girls in Grades 1-5:** Light blue polo or blouse with plaid jumper.
- Girls in Grades 6-8: Light blue polo or blouse with plaid skirt, navy shorts, or navy pants.

We are currently setting up our new uniform items with online school uniform retailers French Toast, Lands End, and Tommy Hilfiger, and will share the info to shop with them soon. Except for the plaid jumpers and skirts, uniform items may be purchased at local stores such as Target, Walmart, and Old Navy.

I realize that some parents purchase uniforms in the next size when they are on sale and want to respect the money spent. Students will not be expected to have the new uniform on the first day of school for the 2022-23 school year; rather we will have a transition period, with the new uniforms to be worn exclusively (i.e., no more navy/khaki pieces) starting with the 2nd quarter of the school year, on **October 28, 2022**.

If your child outgrows the khaki uniform and/or you would like to purchase the new uniforms sooner, students may start wearing the new uniform after Easter break, on **April 25, 2022.**
