Downhill or Tele Skiing/Snowboarding:

- Cost \$103.00 - Payable to Teton High School
- Cost with season pass \$7.00 Bus travel - Payable to Teton High School
- Transportation to Targhee included in price
- Ski Rental: \$18.00 for ½ day payable to Grand Targhee each week or \$72.00 for the four weeks.
- Snowboard Rental: \$21.00 for ½ day payable to Grand Targhee each week or \$84.00 for the four weeks.
- Waiver from Grand Targhee required.

Nordic Track Skiing Grand Targhee:

- Cost \$25.00 - Payable to Teton High School
- If you have a season pass, No charge

- Targhee rental will be \$60.00
- Waiver from Grand Targhee required
