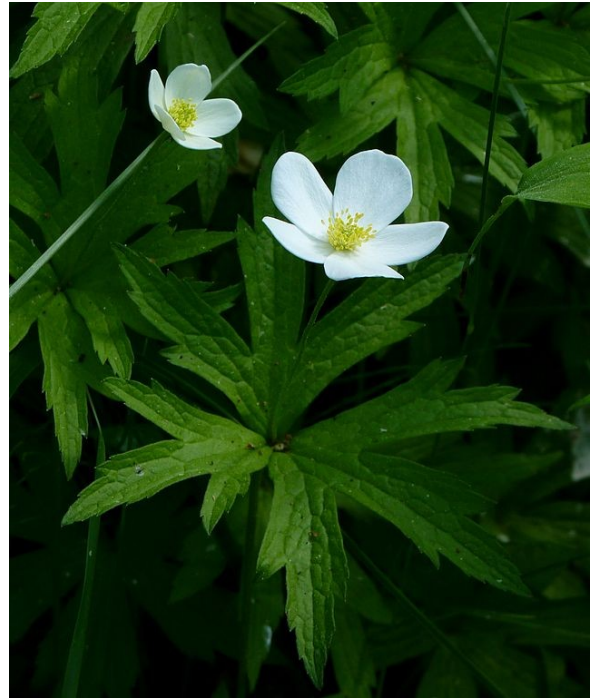


Canada Anemone

This native perennial is great for the woodland border. It does best in consistently moist soils. Anemone provides nectar for several bee and fly species. It has traditionally been used for medical ailments. Caution should be taken in handling as it is known to cause irritation. This plant can be aggressive in the garden so be sure to allow it room to roam.

- Hardiness: Zone 3-9
- Size: 1-2'
- Flower: White in early spring
- Culture: Prefers full to part sun and moist to average soils
- Uses: Great along a stream or pond bank and a natural border, rain garden, nectar source, medicinal
