

Did anybody make this recipe from the last newsletter? The delicious popcorn was at the May meeting and many people asked for the recipe. Since its fall and this is a good time for popcorn, here's the recipe again.

# **Carmel Popcorn**

½ C Popcorn 3 T oil

Pop popcorn and keep warm in a 250<sup>0</sup> oven.

Melt ½ C butter

Add: 1 cup packed brown sugar

¼ C light corn syrup

½ t salt

Bring to a boil

Boil 3 minutes

Remove from heat

Stir in ½ t vanilla and ¼ t baking soda

Pour over warm popcorn and stir well.
