REOPENING RULES FOR THE MASJID

Alhamdulillah, by grace of Allah SWT Masjid Al Mustafa will reopen from May 15th, 2020 In Sha Allah. Still there is risk of contracting COVID19 disease. In-fact the number of cases in Arizona are slowly increasing. We will come to the masjid in this holy month of Ramadan with all precautions to avoid contact disease or spread the disease if we have symptoms. (Be safe and don't cause harm to others).

We must follow following precautions to keep everyone safe.

- 1. Only men are allowed at this time to come to the masjid. Women/sisters and children are **NOT** allowed to come to masjid.
- 2. Brothers ages 65 and above are **NOT** allowed at this time to come to the masjid. (this precaution is for their own safety and wellbeing.)
- Temperature of all the Musallees will be checked before they enter the Masjid. If someone has fever, they will not be allowed to go inside the Masjid.
- 4. Please pray your Sunnah at home. Pray only Fard and Taraweeh salah in the Masjid.
- 5. There will be no bathroom or kitchen access. Please make WUDU at home.
- 6. Maintain Social distancing. **6 feet** apart from each other at all times. New marking is made on the carpets to keep 6 feet distance. Please stand on marked spots only.
- 7. There is only a total of 60 spots in the whole Masjid (all 3 halls) and they will be filled on first come first serve basis. Once all spots are filled, Masjid door will be locked, and no one will be allowed to enter, and no one will be allowed to pray outside the masjid.
- 8. Gathering inside or outside the Masjid is not allowed (before or after prayer).
- Use face mask at all times. If someone does not bring face mask, he will NOT be allowed to enter masjid.
- 10.Bring your own prayer rug. It is also a must and if you don't bring your prayer rug, you will **NOT** be allowed to enter the masjid.
- 11. Please bring your own water bottle.

- 12.Please make WUDU at home. There will be no access to Masjid Bathrooms and Kitchen due to safety reasons.
- 13.If someone has following symptoms they should NOT come to the Masjid. Fever, cough, shortness of breath, tiredness/fatigue, nasal congestion, body aches, sore throat, decrease appetite, diarrhea, headache.
- 14. Brothers with following disease should **NOT** come to masjid.

Heart Diseases, lung diseases (COPD, recent pneumonia), Cancer, HIV disease, Immunocompromised state due to diseases or drugs, like steroids or Biological agents.

(This precaution is also being taken because if patients with above conditions develop Covid 19, their disease is usually more severe, and the outcome may not be favorable).

15.Please wash your hands frequently.

16.Use soap or hand sanitizer frequently.

Masjid **does not** have ample supply of Soap and hand sanitizer. If you have extra supply, please donate to the masjid. Please bring your own hand sanitizer, as Masjid does not have enough supply and will not be able to provide hand sanitizer.

ONLY the **door on south side** (new section built for sisters) will be open. Rest of entrances will be **LOCKED**, and we request brothers NOT to let anyone enter from the other entrances. If someone knocks the door, please ask them to come from the south side door.

Inshallah we will see you soon. May Allah SWT protect everyone.

Keep us and the whole humanity in your prayers.
