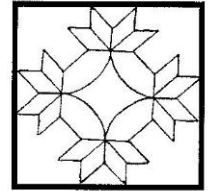


DANCING STARS
2020 Tyler Quilt Show
Presented by the Quilters Guild of East Texas
March 27 & 28, 2020



The Quilt Show Committee has the final decision on quilt category placement and may place a quilt in a more applicable category. Quilt show committee may consolidate or divide categories because of size. QGET reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Mixed Techniques is defined as a quilt containing a significant amount of 2 or more techniques used to develop the design of the top.

Stationary machine is defined as a machine that sits on a table and the fabric is moved to accomplish the quilting.

Track mounted machine is defined as a machine mounted on a movable track and the machine is moved to accomplish the quilting.

NON-JUDGED CATEGORIES:

- 100 Special Exhibit: Art Quilts by Deborah Boschert
Fiber Art and Needlework approved for exhibition by Show Chairmen due to limited space.

JUDGED CATEGORIES:

Large Quilts: (width plus length equals 120 inches or greater; width cannot exceed 110")

- 300 Pieced, Hand Quilted
400 Appliquéd, Hand Quilted
500 Mixed Techniques, Hand Quilted – *PLEASE NOTE TECHNIQUES USED ON ENTRY FORM*
600 Pieced, Quilted with a Stationary Machine
700 Appliquéd, Quilted with a Stationary Machine
800 Mixed Techniques, Quilted with a Stationary Machine– *PLEASE NOTE TECHNIQUES USED ON ENTRY FORM*
900 Pieced, Quilted with a Track Mounted Machine
1000 Appliquéd, Quilted with a Track Mounted Machine
1100 Mixed Techniques, Quilted with a Track Mounted Machine

Quilts, No Size Limitations, Quilted by any Technique

- 1200 Art Quilt: An **original design** which does not use commercial patterns or copy previous works. Design may include but is not limited to a pictorial (animal, human, nature); an exploration of a concept, experience, or shape; an experiment in the creative process; an original evolution of a traditional design; and/or an experimental use of non-traditional media.
1300 Other Techniques: Examples of Other include, but are not limited to, whole cloth, yo-yo, crazy quilt, cathedral window, digital imagery. Also included are surface design techniques such as, thread painting, surface painting.
1400 Modern: Characteristics of modern quilts may include, but are not limited to, the use of bold colors and prints, high value contrast, graphic areas of solid color, improvisational piecing, (design) minimalism, expansive negative space, and/or non-traditional layouts.
1500 First quilt entered in any quilt show.

Small Quilts: (width plus length equals 119 inches or less)

- 1600 Pieced, Machine Quilted, Stationary Machine
1700 Pieced, Machine Quilted, Track Mounted Machine
1800 Appliquéd, Machine Quilted, Stationary Machine
1900 Appliquéd, Machine Quilted, Track Mounted Machine
2000 Mixed Techniques, Machine Quilted, Stationary Machine
2100 Mixed Techniques, Machine Quilted, Track Mounted Machine
2200 Pieced, Applique, Mixed Technique, Hand Quilted

Best Adaptation of Show Theme Ribbon – This ribbon will be awarded by the show judge to the quilt with the most effective adaptation of the theme “Dancing Stars.” Any category is eligible for this award. **Other special awards include:** Sarah Minor Memorial Award for Fine Hand Quilting; Evelyn Howell Memorial Award for Best Traditional Quilt; Exemplary Machine Quilting Award – Stationary Machine; Exemplary Machine Quilting Award – Track Mounted; Exemplary Piecing Award; Exemplary Applique Award; Members’ Choice Award; Viewers’ Choice Award; Rose City Award; Judge’s Recognition; National Association of Certified Quilt Judge’s Award of Merit.

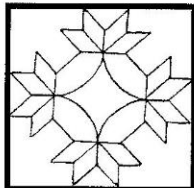

QUILT PREPARATION:

- All quilt entries must contain either hand or machine quilting or a combination of these techniques, except for crazy quilts, yo-yo quilts, and cathedral window quilts. Quilting is defined as a stitch that passes through the top, batting, and backing.
- All quilts must have a sleeve. Instructions for making a sleeve can be found at www.qgetx.org/quiltshow. If quilt is greater than 90 inches in length, the sleeve top must be placed 90 inches from the bottom edge of the quilt.
- A label must be attached on the lower back side of the quilt, showing entrant's name, title of the quilt and phone number.
- Quilts previously shown in the Tyler Quilt Show will not be accepted (EXCEPTION: SPECIAL EXHIBIT ONLY BY INVITATION)
- Quilt readiness: All entries must be clean, in good condition, and odor free.

QUILT SHOW DEADLINES AND INFORMATION– PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- Each quilt entered requires a separate form and one (1) clear 4x6 inch color photo of the entry with your name and the title of the entry printed on the back of the photo.
- Due to space limitations, only the first 250 entries received will be accepted.
- QGET reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- Guild members are limited to five (5) entries. (EXCEPTION: SPECIAL EXHIBIT)
- Non-Guild members must pay \$12 per entry and are limited to three (3) entries. Payment must accompany the entry form. Please make check or money order payable to QGET.
- **All entry forms, photos, and applicable fees must be received by Thursday, February 13, 2020.** Entry forms may be delivered in person at the QGET meeting or mailed to Tana Doss, 15030 Northwood Drive, Tyler, Texas 75703. Questions about entry forms: 903.316.3624 or email: sewetx36@gmail.com . **QGET is not responsible for lost or misdirected mail.**
- Quilts must be physically delivered to Harvey Hall on Tuesday, March 24, 2020, between 8:30 AM and 11:00 AM .
- Please make every effort not to withdraw your quilt less than 4 weeks before the show.
- Shipped entries (not your entry form) are to be shipped to arrive between Tuesday, March 17, 2020 and Friday, March 20, 2020. We cannot be held responsible for delays in delivery. Entries should be shipped in a sturdy box, which will be used to return the quilt. A prepaid mailing label or a check made out to QGET for the exact amount needed for return shipping must be included. Send entries to: **Sharman's Sewing Center, 6005 S. Broadway, Tyler, TX 75703.** In lower left corner please **mark ATTENTION: QGET.** If you want confirmation your quilt was received, please request a delivery confirmation from shipper. Entries being returned will be shipped to the entrant no later than April 6, 2020.
- QGET Members will be on duty during judging and show hours and the premises will be locked during non-show hours and a security guard will be on duty. Every effort will be made to insure the safety of your work while in QGET care, but no responsibility for loss or damage to entries will be assumed by QGET, its officers, agents or volunteers. You are urged to insure your quilt.
- On delivery of quilt each entrant will receive a return receipt for each quilt entered. This return receipt **MUST** be presented to claim your quilt. No entry will be released without a return receipt. All entries must remain on display for the entire show. No entry will be released prior to 6 PM on Saturday, **March 28, 2020.**
- Exhibitors will receive written critique sheets on all judged entries.
- Ribbons will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place entries and Honorable Mention in each category at the discretion of the judge. Best Adaptation of the Theme Ribbon – This ribbon will be awarded by the show judge to the quilt with the most effective adaptation of the show theme "Dancing Stars."
