volunteer hours, this could be the activity for you. For every dozen eggshells that you clean out, dye, fill and cover, you can earn two volunteer hours at Our Lady Star of the Sea School. It can be a great activity to do with your children. You can also purchase them on Amazon, Walgreens, or Walmart as we get closer to Easter. For every \$30 spent on the confetti eggs, you will receive an hour of volunteer time. Just remember to turn in your receipts to Mrs. Klasko.

If you have never made cascarones before, there are plenty of videos on YouTube. I personally like the video titled "How to: Make Cascarones!" by Jackie Gutierrez. To get started you empty the shells, rinse them out, and let them dry. Once you have a dozen shells or more, go ahead and color them. Then let them dry again. After they have dried, you can fill them with confetti or bird seed (I use the latter). Then put a little bit of glue around the opening of the shell and place a small piece of tissue paper or streamer over the opening.

If you decide to make the cascarones, please make sure that your child's name is on the egg carton when you turn them in. I will need all donations by **Tuesday, April 4.**
