Baron & Baroness Report: Their Excellencies reported that the moot went well, they added some members to Tamarack's Hall and recognized Windhaven Archery Corps. Wherefore is coming up on Oct 6 and all are encouraged to attend. TRM are not currently planning to attend but their Excellencies will be holding a small unofficial court for the scouts. Reminder that there needs to be at least one adult with a background check present

and two adults minimum if working with kids. They attended Coronation and TRM are looking to steal the processional war point at Gulf – if going, they prefer Polish garb and are willing to help garb people. Shattered Oak 30th Anniversary is coming up next week, then Wherefore, then Crown Tourney the following week. Harvest Home also coming up.

Old Business:

- <u>T-shirts</u>: Isolda is working with Exchequer so we can use baronial funds on initial outlay with people buying after. Will set up survey to get rough idea of sizing, numbers & long vs short sleeves. Will round up cost to create fundraiser for the barony
- <u>Voting</u>: due to low turnout for meeting, voting for Knight's Marshal and Chronicler will be postponed to the October meeting
- <u>Coronets</u>: Her Excellency reported that she was getting some designs from Countess Gwen; also talked with Gerald Loosehelm is waiting on official estimate but rough cost to refurbish current coronets will be ~\$600. Anonymous Benefactor may be willing to help fund the cost of refurbishment.
- <u>Fall Moot post-mortem</u>: Learned lots, fun was had, lots of food was eaten. Our out of town guests had a good time as well.
- Wherefore Art Thou: Lord Edmond moved that we authorize \$200 gate seed to be repaid after event as requested; THL Aesa seconded with unanimous passage. Reminder that site is bone dry from 9am-5pm otherwise discreetly damp.
