Sale must be cut during the winter months of 2014-2015, and all wood must be trucked out before road restrictions go on in the spring of 2015. Sale will become a gravel pit. Follow all BMP's to prevent and minimize soil disturbance. All slash will remain in harvested area. Sale area shall be kept free of litter at all times.
