The next youth devotional will not be until August 28th.

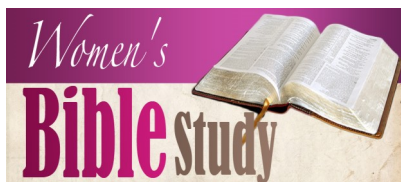

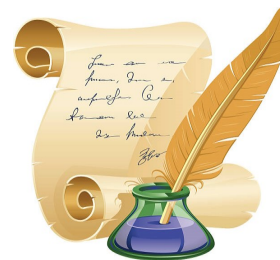

JACK'S CORNER

OUR LIGHT AFFLICTION

“For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory” (2 Cor. 4:17).

Paul, the writer, was imprisoned on several occasions, he was beaten numerous times, and often in danger of death. He was stoned once, shipwrecked three times, and eventually (according to tradition) beheaded for his faith.

So, how could this man speak of *light* affliction?!

Three Reasons:

- (1) Compared to eternity, affliction is but for a moment. If the apostle Paul could refer to his many extreme afflictions as *light*, could we today even say we have afflictions?
- (2) Affliction “works for us.” If we live God’s truth and stand up for God’s truth, we WILL be afflicted/persecuted in some manner. “Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution” (2 Tim. 3:12). Affliction works for us in a positive manner.
- (3) Affliction in Christianity will result in an *eternal* reward. There is nothing else in this life that has such significant recompense. People often fail to understand that they will be remaining forever in eternity SOMEWHERE. If they thought about this often enough, they might recognize whether or not their Christianity is genuine, or only half-hearted. Eternity is a long time to suffer the fires of hell. Do you need to get serious about your Christianity?

“For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us (Rom. 8:18).
