

## .2016 NRAI. .Target & Match Rifle League.

## Competition Dates;

24<sup>th</sup> April,

29<sup>th</sup> May,

12<sup>th</sup> June,

31<sup>th</sup> July

28<sup>nd</sup> August, (final)

Competitors should have their rifles zeroed; fees paid and be present on the firing line for, 12:30 (for TR matches) and 1:20 (of MR matches) on each competition day.

Format of competition Target Rifle League; 2 convertible sighting shots and 15 shots to score at 800 yards. In a change to previous years this year's league will be open to two classes, the traditional TR class (i.e. TR as described in the ICFRA rules) and an open class for rifles other than .308 calibre rifles fitted with aperture sights (not battle sights) and allowed a front rest or sandbag. A briefing will be given on the morning of the first shoot. Targets for both classes will be ICFRA TR targets. If you have any questions please contact us.

Format of competition Match Rifle League; 2 convertible sighting shots and 15 shots to score at 1,000 yards. Rules for this class will be any 308 rifle fitted with either iron sights or telescopic sights. Front rests are allowed but the shooters hand must be placed between the rest and the stock, no back rests, no bi-pods. A briefing will be given on the morning of the first shoot. Targets for the league will be McQueen MR targets. If you have any questions please contact us.

## Competitors will shoot pair style.

(Fouling shots if required shall be taken before competition time and on the zeroing range) (ICFRA rules apply)

Overall league results will be taken from your best two results plus the league final.
