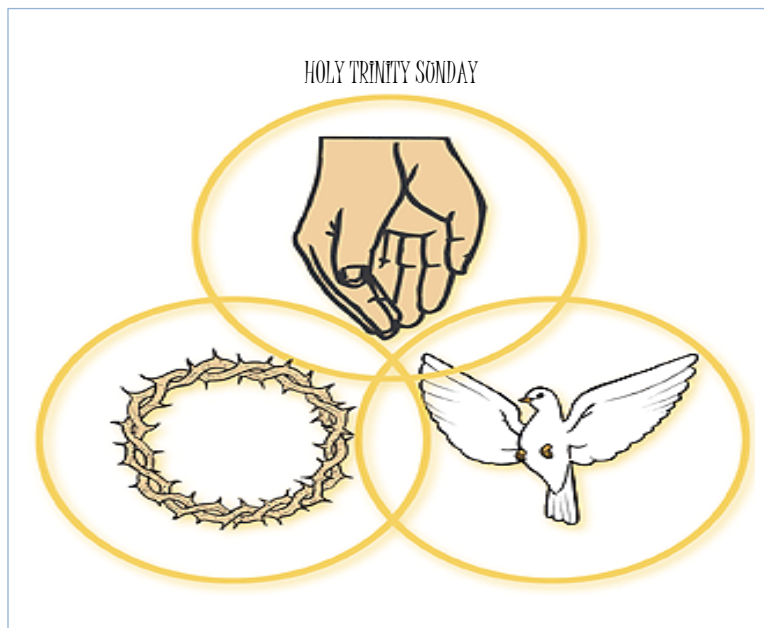

Gratitude in Action: Our Way of Life
