Communication is Key: We do our best to communicate with our Parents about special events and dates. PLEASE make sure you check the mailboxes, e-mails, messages on the check in station, outside board, and papers we post on the doors and near the check in station to stay informed.

PARKING LOT SAFETY: We all are very busy and in a hurry to get to places on time. Although we may be in a hurry, it is important to follow all the signs in the parking lot to ensure every child and parent enters and exits safely. Please enter ONLY through the entrance and exit ONLY through the exit to avoid any potential accidents. Also please do not park in the underpass unless it is raining as this may cause traffic and confusion during drop-offs and pick-ups. Our goal is to ensure the safety of all students and members on our property. If you have any questions or concerns, please speak with a member of the admin staff.

READING IS FUNDAMENTAL: No matter what age your child may be, reading is fundamental to your child's development. By reading a minimum of 15 minutes a day to your child, you can increase their cognitive skills, literacy skills, interest in reading, and even gain a stronger bond with your child.

UNITY DAY: Every month the school recognizes a different country in the world and is introduced to their culture and customs. This month the country we are recognizing is Greece. If you would like a specific country to be recognized or would like to bring us in food or come in and speak about the country, please feel free and speak with Ms. Liz or Ms. Mya.

REVIEWING POLICIES:

- <u>ANNUAL REGISTRATION DUE:</u> This registration fee will help us with supplies and help make our school better. Annual registration will be added to accounts over the next 6 weeks with a charge of \$30 every 2 weeks, although you may pay the full \$90 anytime during the 6 weeks.
- PAYMENTS: Tuition is due on the Monday of the week the children will be attending.
- •<u>LATE PAYMENTS</u>: Any accounts with a balance on Monday at noon will be subject to our late payment fee of **\$15**, as stated on the Parent Handbook.
- •<u>VACATION</u>: If your child will be on Vacation for an entire week, we will charge a **\$40** spot hold fee in place of your Tuition Rate as a courtesy.
- <u>WITHDRAWAL</u>: A two-week written notice is required for all children enrolled in a full-time, part-time, Preschool, or VPK only program. Please note that if you chose to leave without giving us the 2 weeks' notice you will still be in charge of paying the tuition for those 2 weeks.

SUMMER CAMP: We are doing weekly field trips for school-age, VPK, and our VPK Risers so please see front office for details. We also will be hosting some in-house events all summer so be sure to check our website or the front office to view the calendars for a look at the activities, events, and trips planned.

FREE VPK: If your child or someone you know will be 4 years old prior to September 1st, 2019 they are invited to join our fall VPK program which we are now enrolling for! This program is a free preschool program for 3 hours a day. If you require a full day program, we have discounted tuition rates available. Please see a member of admin for more details.
