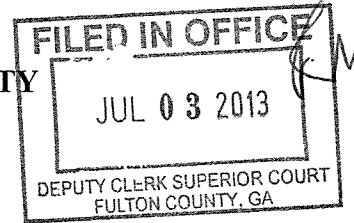

**ORDER QUASHING SUBPOENAS AND PREVENTING FURTHER FRIVOLOUS
FILINGS**

The above-styled matter is before this Court due to Petitioner’s subpoenas issued for July 3, 2013 and August 6, 2013. As Petitioner was previously told in this Court’s June 12, 2013 Order, this Court’s courtroom is not available for her to take depositions. In addition, again, this Court’s Court Reporter is not available to take down those depositions. Accordingly, all subpoenas issued by Petitioner for July 3, 2013 and August 6, 2013 are HEREBY QUASHED.

Petitioner’s behavior has confirmed for this Court that she will continue to engage in frivolous filings. In addition, she has failed to comply with this Court’s June 12, 2013 Order enjoining her from filing any new lawsuits pleadings, motions, or legal documents unless she performed the requirements laid out in that Order.

The Clerk of the Superior Court of Fulton County is HEREBY DIRECTED to not issue any further subpoenas without the permission of the Judge to which Petitioner’s case(s) are assigned. If Petitioner comes to the Clerk’s Office for the purpose of filing a document, she must do the following:

- 1) File a “Request to File” in the Clerk of Court’s Office;

- 2) Attach the document she wishes to file to the "Request" as an "Exhibit";
- 3) Attach to any such pleading, motion, petition, or any other filing, a copy of this Order;
- 4) Attach an affidavit swearing that her filing is not vexatious or frivolous and explaining how it relates to the underlying merits of the case; and
- 5) Deliver a courtesy copy of the Request to the Judge assigned to her case.

Petitioner must then wait for the assigned Judge to grant her permission before her document(s) are filed. In the event that the assigned Judge approves the filing, the Judge's chambers shall contact the Clerk's Office to inform them that the documents may be filed. This procedure applies to the filing of all legal documents, including subpoenas.
