RESOLUTION 2017-76

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS DECLARING NATIONAL NIGHT OUT AS A CITY EVENT AND PROVIDING FOR CITY SUPPORT AND SPONSORSHIP.

WHEREAS, National Night Out is an annual community-building campaign that promotes law enforcement-community partnerships and neighborhood camaraderie to make our neighborhoods safer, more caring places to live; and

WHEREAS, National Night Out enhances the relationship between neighbors and law enforcement while bringing back a true sense of community; and

WHEREAS, in Texas, National Night Out is celebrated on the first Tuesday in October; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sandy Oaks, Texas desires to declare National Night Out as a City event and provide for support and sponsorship;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY OAKS, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS INCORPORATED. The City Council finds the statements made in the preamble above are true and correct and incorporates them into the body of this Resolution as if fully stated herein.

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF NATIONAL NIGHT OUT. The City Council of the City hereby declares the first Tuesday of October National Night Out as a City-wide event.

SECTION 3. SUPPORT AND SPONSORSHIP. The City Council authorizes City sponsorship of National Night Out and expenditures in compliance with the City's budget for each respective fiscal year. Additionally, the City Council authorizes the acceptance of donations from individuals or entities for National Night Out activities.

SECTION 4. ORGANIZATION OF ACTIVITIES. The Mayor or her designee is authorized to organize, plan and implement events and activities for National Night Out on behalf of the City. Nothing in this Resolution prohibits block parties organized by individuals or neighborhoods within the City.
