## **VETERANS' PREFERENCE INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS**



Veterans' preference points cannot be awarded without required documentation, and the documentation must be received by the closing date of the recruitment.

If you are seeking veterans' preference in employment, please complete the attached form and return it with your supporting documentation.

Under Oregon law, armed forces veterans who meet minimum qualifications for a position may be eligible for employment preference. You may be eligible for either 5 points as a Qualified Veteran, or 10 points as a Qualified Disabled Veteran (or spouse), but not both.

If you are a veteran and want to apply for preference points, please submit a completed Sunriver Police Department Veterans' Preference form, as well as provide the required documentation listed on the form. You must submit the documentation to Sunriver Police Department with your application for employment, prior to the closing date on the job announcement.

## **Definitions:**

"Active duty" does not include attendance at a school under military orders, except schooling incident to an active enlistment or a regular tour of duty, or normal military training as a reserve officer or member of an organized reserve or a National Guard unit. Any discharge date is now eligible.

"Veteran" means a person who: (A) Served on active duty with the Armed Forces of the United States;

- For a period of more than 178 consecutive days and was discharged or released from active duty under honorable conditions; or
- For 178 days or less and was discharged or released from active duty under honorable conditions because of a service-connected disability; or
- For at least one day in a combat zone and was discharged or released from active duty under honorable conditions; or
- (B) Received a combat or campaign ribbon for service in the Armed Forces of the United States.
- "Disabled Veteran" means a person entitled to disability compensation under laws administered by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, a person whose discharge or release from active duty was for a disability incurred or aggravated in the line of duty or a person who was awarded the Purple Heart for wounds received in combat. Qualifying spouse may claim points with verification of status on DD214 or an employability or eligibility letter.
- "Armed Forces" means the United States Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, and Coast Guard, including the reserve components thereof. Reserve components mean:
- (a) The Army Reserve;
- (b) The Navy Reserve;
- (c) The Marine Corps Reserve;
- (d) The Air Force Reserve:
- (e) The Coast Guard Reserve;
- (f) The Army National Guard of the United States; and
- (g) The Air National Guard of the United States.
