Figuring Handicap

Your handicap is figured by totaing the number of scratch points scored divided by the number of weeks played. If you have played in the league before, your Team Captain will have your prior seasons average(s). These seasons average(s) will be counted as one weekly score for each seasons average.

EXAMPLE: The first week you actually play you score 12 scratch points. You had played the 3 preceeding seasons with averages of 11.96, 13.85, and 12.82 respectively. The total scores equal 50.63 divided by 4 = 12.6575. This rounds up to 13. (13 is your scratch average) Find 13 on the table at the left and it shows your handicap is 11.

(Hint: Figure last year's average at the 1st weekly total on the Player Average Record, the 2nd average as the 2nd weekly total, etc.)

NOTE: Round your scratch average to figure handicap.
Example: 13.49 rounds to 13 and 13.5 rounds to 14.

**This handicap chart is based on 87.5% of the difference between your scratch average and 26. Handicap is then rounded downward.*
