Town of Stratton Selectmen's Meeting

May 19, 2015

Al Dupell called the meeting to order at 6:30pm at the Stratton Town Office and then the board proceeded to **County Rd.** to observe a culvert scheduled for replacement, located near the Pikes Falls Rd. intersection. The Board discussed some options concerning how to install the headers. Ralph Staib is waiting to hear if the Town received a grant for this project. They will continue discussion on this project at the May 26, 2015 meeting.

Brazers Way: Next, the Selectmen proceeded to a culvert on said road, located downhill of the Stratton Mountain School entrance. Upon observation, the Selectmen agreed that this culvert should be replaced this summer. The Road Foreman will first need to contact Sovernet, which recently had buried cable along this road in the vicinity of this culvert.

West Jamaica Rd.: Upon request of the Stratton Mountain Fire Dept., the Selectmen stopped to observe Nelson's Fire Pond at 183 W. Jamaica Rd. (with Dry Hydrant) to evaluate necessary repairs. The Road Crew may be able to fix the problem. The Road Foreman will inform the board if they cannot easily make repairs.

Adjourn: Chris Liller motioned to adjourn at 7:30p.m.. Greg Marcucci seconded. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned.
