Thank you for participating in one of our summer camps this year. Please find below some information to get you ready for camp. See you soon!

Mission:

The mission of Three Crowns Farm is to provide a safe atmosphere where children of all ages can come and have a great time riding horses, learning, and enjoying other activities around the farm in a fun and positive environment.

What to bring:

All campers are required to bring a packed lunch. Your child is welcome to bring some money to purchase an additional snack, bottled water or item from our treat room. Most kids like to purchase at least one item for an afternoon snack. A beach towel and swim suit are also needed. We may not have water play every day, but will have it scheduled as an activity for one or two days so come prepared daily.

Attire:

Closed toed shoes with socks are a must on the farm! Helmets are provided; however if you have one of your very own please bring it along. Please wear pants suitable for riding (jeans, riding pants, thick legging). Rain or Shine our camp will go on, so please be prepared. We do not ride during extreme heavy rains, storms or unseasonably high temperatures. If such weather conditions occur the Three Crown Farm staff will provide indoor and "in barn" activities for your camper. There's always plenty of grooming, animal care and fun to be had. We also have a large basement in case of inclement weather.

Safety:

Your child's safety comes first at Three Crowns Farm. Our horses are gentle and experienced with children. Only campers or those taking lessons are allowed to play on the farm and participate in farm activities. Please do not allow siblings to play in the barns and on the play sets at the farm. We encourage all campers to apply sunscreen once before coming to camp each morning. Campers will be able to reapply sunscreen after lunch each day. Our staff will assist the younger campers with proper application. If your child has any allergies or medical conditions please let us know prior to camp.

Riding Levels:

Our instructors will complete an evaluation for each rider and place them in the group that is appropriate for them. If you wish to keep certain campers together please let us know by writing it on the back of your enrollment sheet. Our Equine Manager(s) will decide the level of the camper and place your child in the group that can offer him/her the best camp experience.

Rules:

Campers are expected to respect the Three Crowns Staff, the farm animals and the farm itself. There are no electronic devices allowed during camp hours. They can turn on their phones at the last few minutes of camp.

Camp Sessions:

Campers can sign up for multiple sessions. Campers that sign up for multiple sessions may be placed in a more advanced group during their second or third session. Basically, we will ensure your child gets a new experience during each session. The Three Crowns staff will determine the best group for your child. Each group will have 2-3 hours of riding time. Some days we have bareback class in the afternoons. There will also be a horsemanship class, an hour long art class, some fun camp activities, barn yard animal activities and play time.
