**Note:** Reciprocity recipients are subject to the NMCBBHP recertification requirements which are different than the national recertification requirements – NMCBBHP recertification is required every 2 years, requires 40 CEUs which include 6 ethics CEUs, and 6 cultural competency CEUs.
