Shift Meeting:

- Record training as:

- Check the 1021: plan a work day objective, when you have a meeting with your crew to discuss the events of the shift.
- Record Actual hours

Daily Vehicle Maintenance/ Inspection:

- Record training as:
 - 'Daily Activities, NFPA 1500, Daily Vehicle maintenance/inspection, NFPA 1002 4.2'.
- Record 0.5 hour

Daily Air-boat/trailer/tow vehicle morning inspection/maintenance:

- Record training as:
 - "Air-boat Training"
 - "Daily boat check and maintenance."
- Record actual hours

Weekly/Monthly Preventative Maintenance:

- Record training as:
 - 'Daily Activities, NFPA 1500, Weekly/Monthly Preventative Maintenance, NFPA 1002 4.2'.
- Record Actual hours

Appraisal Review: Monthly appraisal review. Lieutenants and D/C's complete monthly appraisals on their personnel in Target Solutions Forum.

- Record training as:
 - 'Officer Training NFPA 1021- Fire Officer I & II Training, NFPA 1021 / Complete a Personnel Evaluation/ Monthly Evaluation'.
 - Fill in all required fields.
- Record Actual hours

Tools & Equipment: Training on the tools in the Compartment of the Day. If there is no applicable tool in the assigned compartment, choose a tool to review. Make certain that each tool is properly identified (Dept. I.D., unit # and color code).

 - ‘Company Training, NFPA 1001 – 05: Skills Sheet 5-I-9 Change an SCBA cylinder - One-person method. (NFPA 1001, 5.3.1)’
 - Record one (1) hour

Monthly Extinguisher Inspections:

- Record training as:
 - ‘Company Training, NFPA 1001 – 06: Portable Fire Extinguishers’ / Inspecting Portable Fire Extinguishers
 - Record Actual hours

Safety Surveys: Monthly assigned inspections of commercial occupancies.

- Record the following objectives:
 - ‘Company Training, NFPA 1001 – 20: Fire Prevention and Public Education / Fire Inspections’.
 - ‘Pre Fire Planning Inspections, NFPA 1620 –Pre Plan Annual Review’ (or ‘New Plan’ if appropriate).

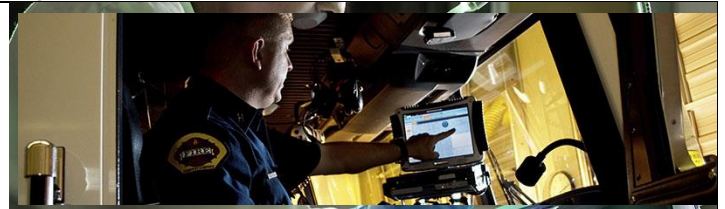
