Application Package for Scholarship from AGMA:

The application must be signed, completed and submitted to the AGMA Scholarship Committee at 4915 Oxford Dr., Mobile, AL 36618. If an applicant fails to complete the entire application or fails to submit all of the items in the format requested hereunder by the deadline date, the application will not be considered for any purposes or under any circumstances with respect to the scholarship of the AGMA.

Please note the application must be signed by both the student applying for the scholarship and the parent/guardian of the applicant. If either of such signatures is not on the application, the application will be considered incomplete and not considered in the application process.

The Scholarship Committee must receive the application with all required attachments and submissions no later than May 31, 2021.

AGMA does not and will not discriminate on the basis of race, color, sex, religion, national origin or on any other basis in either the application process or the granting of scholarships.

By submitting the application package, the applicant and his or her parent/guardian signing the application are certifying the submitted information is true and correct. Applicants and their parent/guardian are also agreeing to the conditions set forth below:

Scholarship Conditions

The terms and conditions on which scholarships are awarded for the 2021 scholarship year, are as follows:

1. The scholarship shall be only granted to graduation high school seniors.
2. The scholarship amount will be determined by the Scholarship Committee based on available funds in the AGMA Scholarship Fund.
3. The scholarship will be available after the decision of the Scholarship Committee in June 2021.
4. The scholarship is a one-time scholarship payable to the student.
5. In order to qualify for the scholarship, the student must attend a four year college, a junior college, a technical or vocational school after high school graduation.
6. In order to qualify for the scholarship, the applicant must be a dependent child of an AGMA member.
7. The scholarship will not be awarded solely based on need.
