THE ISSUES

There are two approaches to governance in our city. My approach prioritizes our residents and aims to stabilize our city's finances to enhance essential community services.

The current officeholder has allocated millions to the West Covina Health Department without authorizing any new police officers. Further expenditures include millions on the SportsPlex, including substantial increases in her own pay and benefits. All decisions made without conducting any financial review or analysis.

No other candidate has a public opinion prior to the campaign.

- 1. **West Covina Health Department:** By eliminating entirely the city avoids bankruptcy. Other cities' cost estimates range from \$60 million to \$90 million to initiate the project.
- 2. **Public Safety:** Allocate \$4.2 million of \$7.0 million overtime budget to hire up to 25 new officers, bolsters community safety.
- 3. **West Covina SportsPlex:** Over the past three years, incurred losses exceeding \$3 million. Returning management to outside third party will redirect funds to street repairs and other needs.
- 4. **\$100,000 Pay/Benefits Increase:** Roll back 265% stipend increase, returning compensation to \$765 per month. Also eliminate new Department Head Benefits (Med, Retire, Other).
