Responsive Reading

May 6, 2018, Psalm 116:1-9 "I Love the Lord"

Lead: I love the LORD, because He has heard My voice and my supplications.

Cong: Because He has inclined His ear to me, Therefore I will call upon Him as long as I live.

Lead: The pains of death surrounded me, And the pangs of Sheol laid hold of me; I found trouble and sorrow. Then I called upon the name of the LORD: "O LORD, I implore You, deliver my soul!"

Cong: Gracious is the LORD, and righteous; Yes, our God is merciful. The LORD preserves the simple; I was brought low, and He saved me.

Lead: Return to your rest, O my soul, For the LORD has dealt bountifully with you. For You have delivered my soul from death, My eyes from tears, And my feet from falling.

Together: I will walk before the LORD in the land of the living.

May 13, 2018, Hebrews 6:10-15 "God's Promises Bring Hope"

Lead: God is not unjust. He will not forget your work and the love you have shown him as you have helped his people and continue to help them.

Cong: We want each of you to show this same diligence to the very end, so that what you hope for may be fully realized.

Lead: Then you will not become spiritually dull and indifferent. Instead, imitate those who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised.

Cong: When God made his promise to Abraham, since there was no one greater for him to swear by, he swore by himself, saying,

Lead: "I will surely bless you and I will multiply your descendants beyond number."

Together: And so after waiting patiently, Abraham received what was promised.

Responsive Reading

May 20, 2018, Psalm 91:1-11 "God's Mighty Hand of Protection"

- **Lead:** Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."
- **Cong:** Surely he will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence. He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart.
- **Lead:** You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day, nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday.
- **Cong:** A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you. You will only observe with your eyes and see the punishment of the wicked.
- **Lead:** If you say, "The Lord is my refuge," and you make the Most High your dwelling, no harm will overtake you, no disaster will come near your tent.

Together: For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways;

May 27, 2018, 1 John 4:7-14 "Let us Love One Another"

- **Lead:** Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God.
- **Cong:** Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love. This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him.
- **Lead:** This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.
- **Cong:** No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us.
- **Lead:** This is how we know that we live in him and he in us: He has given us of his Spirit.
- Together: And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent his Son to be the Savior of the world.
