Re: For Immediate Release – Minimally-invasive cancer treatment offered by Acadiana Radiology Group

Dr. Benjamin Henderson and Dr. Blaine Hoppe of Acadiana Radiology Group have established Y-90 radioembolization treatment at Our Lady of Lourdes Regional Medical Center. This minimally invasive outpatient procedure is a treatment targeted for inoperable tumors that reside in or have spread to the liver. This therapy is designed to reduce tumor size and slow tumor growth, as well as alleviate symptoms caused by the disease leaving healthy tissue relatively unaffected. This procedure may be an option when other treatments such as surgery or transplant have been excluded. According to the American Cancer Society (ACS), the percentage of Americans developing liver cancer has slowly been rising over the last several decades. The ACS projects over 35,000 new cases to be diagnosed in 2015. Determination for candidacy is a multi-disciplinary approach that may include your oncologist, surgeon, primary care physician, interventional radiologist, as well as other members of your medical team. Drs. Henderson and Hoppe also perform several other procedures for cancer treatment including transarterial hepatic chemoembolization with drug eluting beads (DEBTACE) and tumor radiofrequency ablation (RFA).
