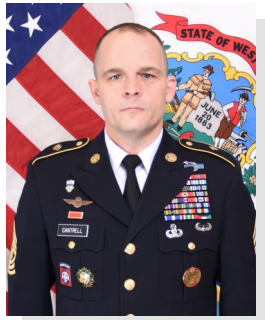

The West Virginia State Council Vietnam Veterans Mobile Wall serves as a Memorial for all West Virginia's Vietnam Veterans who served during the Vietnam War. This wall only includes the names of West Virginians who were killed in action, held as Prisoners Of War, and those still Missing in Action on the soils of South Vietnam, North Vietnam, its seaways and theater of operation. This list includes over 732 West Virginians who are true heroes that gave their lives in the Vietnam War for their country and this proud State. The "Modern Wall" (1975-2017) is an addition to include fallen WV soldiers from other wars.
