March Reflection

Luke 19:37-38 "As Jesus was now approaching the path down from the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to praise God joyfully with a loud voice for all the deeds of power they had seen, saying, 'Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven, and glory in the highest heaven!"

I have heard it said that some people prefer the winter months because you can always put on more clothes to stop being cold, but you can only take off so many clothes to cool down when you are hot. While I appreciate the power of positive thinking, I much prefer warmer weather. I can't wait to break out the golf clubs, go hiking, and maybe just maybe dust off the old fishing pole.

We are now moving into the month of March, and the doldrums of February and January are safely behind us. If you are like me this is reason to celebrate, because hopefully you can now put your long johns back in the closet. Of course in the excitement of the change of seasons we sometimes lose focus, because there are so many new things to do.

As it stands today we find ourselves almost a month before we celebrate the glorious resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on Easter Sunday. What a blessing it is to find ourselves on the doorsteps of life eternal, of course we have not yet reached Jerusalem, the road to Golgotha is still before us, and when you woke up today you may have had the distinct feeling that you were still in the wilderness.

As Christians we are still in the wilderness, journeying through this season of Lent. We have not yet reached our final destination; we are still lost in the sea of our own human sinfulness. One of the most frustrating things about the season of Lent is that it has the propensity to be isolating. Through practicing repentance, and abstaining from certain practices we have the tendency to feel lost. Sometimes in our isolation we want to move quickly to the final destination of Easter, but this is a mistake. The wilderness can be formative, moving too quickly can cause us to miss the lessons we are to learn.

In the Luke passage that is referenced at the beginning of this reflection Jesus is making his triumphal entry into Jerusalem. The people are excited, there is a party going on when Jesus enters the city, folks are laying down their jackets, and you would think the rolling stones were in town or something. Of course as we know that excitement shifts very quickly and in a matter of days this same crowd will be shouting, "crucify him!"

We know that Easter is on the way, and on Easter we will celebrate like there is no tomorrow, but we have yet to reach our destination. As it stands today, we are in the wilderness. As we move ever closer to the cross, I hope that you will take some time to continue to reflect upon the story of Jesus Christ, his life, death, and resurrection. Don't rush into the final destination of Easter, spend a little time getting lost in the

wilderness. Take a few moments each day to think about your relationship to God, through daily prayer and scriptural reflection. May you nurture your walk of discipleship through introspection and doing the hard work of loving God and loving your neighbor. I pray that your time in the wilderness will prepare you for future faithfulness as you strive to be the hands and feet of Jesus Christ!

Mar. 21 - corn


Mar. 28 - chicken or tuna helper
