

# Industry Update—Hazardous Materials Permits by Pete Munoz

Hello Guys I want to pass some information I received the other day. I ran into a Fire Inspector with the City of San Antonio. He asked if he could speak to management. We met with the Fire Inspector and he ask if we had a Hazardous Materials permit. In our case we have a Generator and it has diesel fuel which is Hazardous. The Fire Inspector said that this was NOT a new law its been in effect since 1991 but never enforced. So here is what I found out about the permit.

There is a one time fee that is billed there is also the permit fee which depends on the size of the Hazardous material. If you have several Hazardous Materials they only bill for one. They also go by which one of the Hazardous Materials you have the most of on your property. In my case the generator is a 150 gallon and the diesel weighs 8lbs per gallon put me at 1200lbs. You will need to get the Hazardous signage as well and place it on the door leading to were you have your Hazardous chemicals.

The Fire Department they will give you 3 months to comply. The permit is by calendar year not from when you get the permit. I have attached the information on the fees I am working on get the application for the HAZMAT permit. We will be updating the web site to include the application for the permit.
