

PPHA SHOW RULES

1. All riders under 18 must wear a helmet when riding outside the show arena.
2. Exhibitors will not be allowed in class once the gate has been closed.
3. Any protest must be in written form accompanied by a \$50.00 deposit and submitted to the show committee within 48 hours of the finals. If the protest is disallowed, deposit is forfeited. No one shall approach a judge regarding a decision until after the show with a steward preset. Unsportsmanlike conduct will result in being expelled from the grounds and entry fee will be forfeited. Exhibitor complaints must be declared with payment. ANY CHANGES must be declared in writing in the SHOW OFFICE prior to class.
4. PtHA Rules apply to all PtHA classes/APHA Rules apply to all APHA classes.
5. Open Classes will follow PtHA Rules.
6. PtHA Leadline and Novice classes are non-ROM classes.
7. "Walk/Trot only" classes open to all breeds/all ages, but exhibitors may not cross enter in three gaited classes.
8. Numbers must be worn on each side of your pad in performance classes.
9. Show Management reserves the right to cancel this event without notice and without liability any time prior to the contest. In this case, all entry money will be refunded.
10. This show is approved for points by PtHA and APHA. Entries must be made in accordance with PtHA and APHA Rules. All horse owners or lessees must show a current PtHA membership card or purchase one at the show. PtHA registration papers, type card, or photocopies of both sides of those items must be presented at the show office when entering the show. Show rules are those of the current PtHA and APHA Rule Books.
12. By entering this show owners, lessees, and exhibitors agree that PtHA, APHA, Show Managers, Show Secretaries, show grounds, and show committee will not be held responsible for any losses, injuries, damages, or debts in connection with this show.
13. All dogs must be on a leash no longer than 6' while being led and 10' when tied.
14. High Points will be figured using the PtHA points system.
15. You must be a current member of PPHA to be eligible for high point awards and year end awards.
16. High Points are on horse/one rider
17. Any ties will be broken by the tie breaker judge.

NOTE: MUST SHOW IN A MINIMUM OF THREE CLASSES FOR DIVISION HIGH POINT AWARD.
