

#### **2023 Spring Speakers**

Chad Niman, has experience in wood products marketing and hardwood grading systems including: tree, veneer, hardwood lumber, railway tie and log grading systems. Chad is a Primary Forest Product Specialist with the University of Kentucky Department of Forestry and Natural Resources, interim Assistant Director to RCARS Research Station and Secretary/Treasurer of the Ohio Valley Lumber Drying Association. He is focused on helping to transfer information related to regulatory and market changes, as well as providing assistance in the areas of utilization and market development. He is one of the authors in the annual Kentucky Forest Sector Economic Contribution Report.

Henry Quesada, is a professor in the Department of Forestry and Natural Resources at Purdue University. He is currently performing duties as the Agriculture and Natural Resources (ANR) Program Leader and Assistant Director of Extension. Henry oversees the programming, strategic direction, financial aspects, and policy of ANR Extension Programs. Before moving to Purdue, Henry developed an international program on continuous improvement, product development, and new markets for forest products industries at Virginia Tech. Henry has been instrumental in the developments to incorporate hardwood species into the mass timber market.
