





There's lots that's new with Corvette Racing for 2020. First of all, they have two new, mid-engine C8.R race cars – the No. 3 in familiar yellow with silver accents and the No. 4 in silver with splashes of yellow.

Did you know that the race car was developed simultaneously with the 2020 Corvette Stingray?

There is also a new driver on the team. As you read in previous newsletters, Jordan Taylor has joined Corvette Racing as a full-time driver sharing the No. 3 car with Antonio Garcia. Jordan drove for his father's team (Wayne Taylor racing) for eight years but is no stranger to Corvette Racing. He drove for the team at the 24 Hours of Le Mans every year from 2012 through 2017, winning the GTE Pro class in 2015 with codrivers Oliver Gavin and Tommy Milner.

Also new is a different endurance codriver – Nicky Catsburg – who was third driver in the No. 3 for the recent 24 Hours of Daytona race. He'll join Jordan and Antonio for the Sebring and Petit races; the 24 Hours of Le Mans is TBC.

What's *not* new is Corvette Racing's quest to achieve their 100th IMSA victory, which should occur during the 2020 race season.

It should be noted, however, that Corvette Racing has already achieved 100 wins; by combining IMSA wins and Le Mans wins, they obtained their 100th win with the No. 4 car's victory at Long Beach in April 2018.

FEBRUARY, 2020

By now, you've read about the *Daytona* race and the team's standing after 24 hours, so I'll keep this brief.

The No. 3 Corvette C8.R finished in fourth-place, the team having enjoyed a mostly trouble-free race in the debut of this new car. They completed 785 laps for 2,794.6 miles; they led twice and victory looked possible for the majority of the race. The potential of the mid-engine Corvette was obvious.

The No. 4 Corvette C8.R driven by Oliver Gavin, Tommy Milner and Marcel Fässler dealt with numerous problems on Saturday and Sunday but ultimately finished the race. Things looked optimistic in the first eight hours with the team racing inside the top-five, but an oil leak (*requiring the engine to be removed*!) forced the No. 4 into the garage for extensive repairs for the next <u>nine</u> hours. Once completed the No. 4 went back into the race in order to evaluate tire settings and setup options to help the No. 3 for the end of the race.

So, no podiums this time but hopes are high that the new C8.Rs will be victorious this season.

Corvette Racing's next race is the Mobil 1 Twelve Hours of Sebring Fueled by Fresh from Florida on March 20-21 at Sebring (Fla.) International Raceway.

Those of you with *Velocity* as part of your cable or satellite TV package will see the race in its entirety. For others, we will see approx. 1 hour of the beginning and another hour or so of the race-end courtesy of TSN.


