They Went Wacko In Waco Lesson In History Part 22



Military type raid on a religious complex in Waco, Texas - February 28, 1993

Nearly everyone in the entire world by now should be aware of the military type raid on a religious complex in Waco, Texas on February 28, 1993. This attack and siege is but the latest of a long series of nebulous and sometimes none-existent warrants being served on private citizens by the so-called Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (BATF) and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), using crushing and exceedingly excessive force. The brutality exercised during all of these raids of the past several years shows a total lack of respect for the Bill of Rights and it compares with the brutality exercised by other totalitarian governments

over the past several hundred years. I will use the letters ATF for the remainder of this article with an explanation.

The liberty-conscious citizens of our country are rapidly becoming alarmed (and alerted) and they want to know why. From the multitude of radio talk shows and from discussions overheard in the public places of America, the people are openly discussing the courses of action available to correct this un-Godly and un-American situation. The most prevalent question in the United States today is, "Why is this happening?"

To study that question we must go to history. Therefore, we are combining the current national affairs of the Waco story with our history lesson. The origination of the current actions of the ATF, the U.S. Marshalls office and the FBI is historical and many of the names of persons and organizations have been revealed in past history lessons.

The story of Waco and this Lesson In History is complex and it comes in two parts, the exoteric and the esoteric. The exoteric means that which is available to the common person without the knowledge available to those initiated in the occultic secret societies. In the case of the Waco affair, the exoteric is that information and knowledge we obtain from the newspapers, television and radio. It is that knowledge that the controlled media is authorized to give us. It has become obvious to any intelligent, thinking person that only a very small fraction of the truth is being given to us.

The esoteric is that which is available only to the initiated elite. The background of the Waco affair, as well as the other incidents of ATF brutality, is totally esoteric. In no way does this excuse them but it is doubtful if the majority of the ATF and FBI agents assigned

to these missions of hobnailed brutality really know why they are there or who gives the orders. We all have become deeply involved in a psychological war of such proportions that if it isn't ended soon, possibly violently, Western mankind, as we have known it, will cease to exist.

The exoteric information available. First, we will give a review of the information that has been made public by the highly controlled news media. As we shall see, there are some members of the national news media who know that they are being controlled but most of them are not strong enough spiritually to openly oppose their masters. However, throughout this ordeal at Waco there are a few news reporters who are openly defiant of the orders from their own supervisors and the government as well. They sense that there is a bigger story in there somewhere and they are trying to find it and the government is threatening them.

The raid on the Waco Complex, known as the "Branch Davidian" of the Seventh Day Adventist Church, had been planned for nearly a year. Photographs taken by aircraft provided the exact dimensions of all of the structures as well as the location of windows and doors. County and State maps were studied to find the source of water, power and phone lines. Their source of energy for heating and cooking was analyzed.

A replica of the entire compound was constructed somewhere in Arkansas, probably Fort Chaffee, and the ATF practiced assaulting the replica in training for the planned raid at Waco. Each agent had his assigned function and he was not to deviate from his position. The timing for each agent to be at his assigned position had to be perfect. They did this, over and over, for three months. It was to be a military type operation in every aspect and it was to be conducted with the same precision as that of the Delta Forces or the Special Forces.

The ATF psychiatrists conducted "psychological profiles" on the church's leader Vernon Howell, aged 33 (known as David Koresh), as well as all of the other leaders within the religious complex. The ATF studied the means of financial support for the church's operation. They knew that there had been considerable money donated to the operation of the church in addition to the work the members of the church were conducting in the community.

In the government's surveillance of the Branch Davidian operation, it was learned that the members made numerous trips into Waco to purchase the necessities of life as well as for entertainment. David Koresh himself also made numerous trips into town for the same purpose. Mr. Koresh liked to jog for exercise and he was seen on many occasions running along the roads and streets near and in Waco. The local sheriff knew him and visited with him occasionally.

But the Branch Davidians sensed that danger was imminent and consequently quit visiting the city several weeks prior to the raid. The ATF and the FBI stated in their news conferences that David Koresh quit leaving the complex six months before the raid. Local citizens openly state that it was only two weeks. Keep in mind the fact that the replica had been built in Arkansas and assault training had been conducted for three months.

Directly across the road from the complex there is an empty house. Suddenly, six young men about 30 years old, acting as college students from the local college, moved into the vacant house. These young men quickly showed an interest in the religious training at the Branch Davidian Church and asked to attend the training sessions. Koresh toured the young

men through most of the complex and explained the daily routine to them. David Koresh realized that they were under surveillance. However, he continued to welcome the men for training sessions.

On Sunday, February 28, 1993, only one of the young men came to visit the church. He stayed for approximately one half hour and then left, returning to the house across the street. He stayed in the church complex long enough to determine that everything was normal in the church with no unusual actions. A phone call was received by Mr. Koresh during the short stay but there was nothing unusual after the phone call. The ATF spokesman later stated at a news conference that they did not have a telephone tap on the complex's line. The six men then left the house across the road.

David Koresh and the other leaders of the Branch Davidian are very intelligent men. They knew something was about to happen. For some time they had observation posts manned, not only with ordinary binoculars but with sophisticated infra-red night vision equipment. The observation tower appears to be forty to fifty feet high. From such a height trained men could observe for miles.

At 9:40 AM, February 28, the extensive training of the ATF agents turned into the real thing. This was about 45 minutes after the one young man left the complex, joined his five comrades across the road, and then all of them left. This gave the men inside the church adequate time to get into position. The observers in the observation tower saw the Feds coming, hunched down in several cattle trailers.

The ATF was devastated, and still are. They have subsequently stated repeatedly that their element of surprise was lost. All of their training was predicated on the element of surprise. They now accuse the media of causing that loss of the element of surprise because the local paper had published an article regarding the Branch Davidian complex in the February 27 paper. It is reported that the ATF has now sued the paper for releasing that story!

No, that newspaper article didn't do it. While the agents were travelling to the scene, crouched in their cattle trailers, they passed two Bronco type vehicles with television reporters in them. They didn't stop the vehicles to ascertain if their element of surprise was lost. Sure enough, in broad daylight, at 9:40 AM, on a bright day, the entire assault on the complex was on video film! The agents were seen by town people to get out of busses, change into camouflage combat gear and get into the cattle trailers. This was done in public parking lots in the city! It is discussed in town by many people who have overheard in the Waco bars statements like, "If you want to see some shooting and killing, go out to the Davidian complex on Sunday morning!" Statements such as these are being heard repeatedly on talk show radio programs in the area. The element of surprise was lost many days before the actual assault.

Why did the Branch Davidian members feel that they had a need to protect themselves in this manner? It was because they had a very deep-seated religious belief in an Apocalyptic Armageddon. This is a very complex subject with respect to the Waco affair and it will be discussed in detail in the esoteric section.

What happened when this extensively drilled assault team arrived in their trailers at the complex? Some of the story has been seen on national TV but not all of it. According to eyewitness accounts, as discussed on local talk radio, the agents went into position, some with ladders to breach the building from the roof. One, or more, went to the front door. David Koresh stepped outside unarmed. He told the agents to go away and returned to the door. It is reported that one agent climbed his ladder and accidentally discharged his weapon with the bullet striking his leg or foot. He yelled that he was hit and that started the

shooting by the ATF! Koresh was hit in the thigh and side and rapidly retreated into the complex.

The men inside the complex commenced firing and four ATF agents were killed with 15 wounded. The number of killed and wounded inside the complex is not fully determined at this time but it is somewhere around the same number. Military helicopters were flying sorties low over the complex presumably trying to land in the complex. The Branch Davidians apparently were ready for that, too. They had acquired a semi-automatic 50 cal. rifle, readily available on the open market and legal, and had used it to down three of the helicopters. They didn't destroy the aircraft but rather shot out the engines which forced the choppers to auto-rotate to the ground!

A local citizen, driving along a nearby road, saw one of the helicopters land rather hard in an open field. Several ATF agents scrambled out of the aircraft. The man ran over believing they might be hurt and wanted to offer help. The agents forcefully and roughly threw the man to the ground, face down in very wet mud. They forced him into the ground with their boots in his back in such a way that he was forced to suck in some muddy water and dirt into his lungs. Using vile words, they asked him what he meant, coming up to the chopper. The man explained that he wanted to help them. They continued to curse him and told him, in vile words, to get out of there.

The video of the shootout was received by a local resident from the uplink to the satellite and was an unedited version. It was the entire scene as observed apparently by the reporters in those two Bronco type vehicles. Others in the area have reported that there were several TV trailers along one of the roads in the area with their uplink dish antennas already in place when the assault took place. From whatever source, the video was received and has been reproduced and distributed.

The video shows a scene of compassion on the part of the Branch Davidians. Apparently the ATF asked for a truce in order for them to retrieve their dead and wounded. It is reported that the video shows agents approaching the complex with their hands up, unarmed. They are then shown retrieving their dead and wounded. This obviously was a humiliating experience for the federal government!

The government went into a damage control scenario immediately. It is stated that the President ordered the FBI to take over the negotiations with the Branch Davidians. Experienced Christians in the country would not necessarily think that was the correct approach. It was the FBI that was in charge at Ruby Ridge during the Randy Weaver assault last fall. It was the FBI that was in charge at Smithville, Arkansas when, the local sheriff and Gordon Kahl were killed unnecessarily by federal agents. It is well known by Christian Patriots how both of those incidents turned out! In all probability, the Branch Davidians at Waco, Texas knows the details of those incidents.

Their first order was to force the news media away from the site another 2 or 3 miles. They were already 2 miles away. According to reporters, this put the news media out of reach of detailed photographs. They say that sounds of additional gunfire, on the part of either the Davidians or the government, would be difficult to hear. Movements of personnel could now be done in secret. Many are rationalizing that the Branch Davidians obviously knew what was going on because they are right there in the middle of it with their observation tower still being manned. The government would now be free to do anything they desired without the American people knowing what really happened.

Realizing that this action was causing discussions on First Amendment rights violations, it was determined that a news conference would be held each morning in the Waco Conference Center. The daily news conferences are broadcast live on the local radio station.

Other outlets throughout the country use only segments of the conference; consequently, the bulk of the American people know very little about the activities at Waco. Our contacts in the Waco area record the live radio broadcasts of the conference and we here at Christian Crusade for Truth have copies of those recordings.

Each morning, the news media arrives on schedule. The FBI agent in charge opens the conference with a prepared statement reflecting the actions of the previous day. The conference is then opened for questions from the "approved" news media. The questions are universally those that are considered "politically correct." There are occasional incidents of where even the "approved" media would attempt a question that would reveal information that the government doesn't want the American people to know. Such questions are refused promptly and firmly.

However, even with the "politically correct" questions that were asked, the citizens of the surrounding area could piece together the questions asked with the answers given by the government and then compare that information with what they knew for a fact to be happening. They realized that there was a massive coverup of the facts. They contacted Ron Engleman, a talk show host on a powerful 50,000 watt station in the Dallas area. It incensed Ron Engleman that the national news releases were not consistent with the observations being made by the local citizens. Consequently, he devoted several hours each day to the discussion of the Waco incident. The program became a "sounding board" for the truth. People, who had belonged or still belong to the Branch Davidian group there at Waco would call in and report the actual conditions and beliefs of the church.

Obviously, the officials also listened to Ron Engleman's talk show, not only for intelligence purposes but to learn of the concern and anger of the local people. As time progressed we could compare the information released at the daily news conference with the information being discussed on Ron Engleman's talk show. It became obvious that the information being released by the agent in charge each morning at the news conference would be modified as necessary to counter the information learned from the Ron Engleman program. It became a game of "cat and mouse" between the government, the media, the towns-people and the Branch Davidians. Contrary to the national news releases, David Koresh also understands psychological warfare. It appears that even though he is at the mercy of the total firepower of the United States, he psychologically is in command.

In one of the early news conferences a reporter asked if the FBI and the ATF were planning on using psychological warfare. The agent in charge responded by saying that he didn't know what psychological warfare was! This was incredulous to all knowledgeable people listening to those words! It was but a few days later that it was announced over the media that the Davidians were playing music extremely loud at night to keep the agents awake. Again, the local people knew better and discussed it on the Ron Engleman show. The government then changed their announcements that the loud music was being beamed to the complex by the government in an attempt to force them to out. The loud music changed to sounds of helicopters, tanks, cows, bugles, Eastern occult music, etc. It was openly discussed on the Engleman show that this is psychological warfare and it causes adrenalin depletion along with sleep deprivation. This technique is very effective prior to an attack.

Ron Engleman made a statement directed to the Davidian complex. He asked that if they were listening would they put out a signal of some sort. The complex painted a sign on a sheet and hung it out of an upstairs window saying, "God help us. Send us the Press." Obviously, this upset the officials considerably. Because of Mr. Engleman's efforts, there have been many editorials printed in establishment newspapers condemning the "lack of professionalism" on his part! Efforts have been made to get him fired and perhaps even

legal action contemplated. We must pray for his safety and thank God for those few men and women of the media who still serve the American principles.

The news media, on several occasions, asked the agent in charge of the news conferences what the warrant stated that prompted the assault. The response has continued to be that the Warrant is sealed. The consensus among Christian patriots is that there probably was no warrant and they used the multitude of past examples for the authority of that statement. The agent in charge would simply say that the investigation revealed that the complex was stockpiling weapons. When asked what kind of weapons, the answer was always "handguns, rifles, ammunition, that sort of thing." The agent in charge also stated that they didn't know if anyone in the complex had a Federal Firearms License! The local people thought that statement also to be incredulous. Federal Firearms Licenses are very tightly controlled and are a matter of record to include the name and address, along with all kinds of other data. This is purposefully done to keep track of the location of each licensee. Five minutes work at a computer would tell if there was a license within the complex.

The sheriff of each county within the United States is the highest ranking law official in the county. He is elected directly by the people and he represents them. It is the sheriff who is responsible to serve warrants regardless of the origin. The sheriff of the county (McLennan) in which the Davidian complex is located should have been the person serving that warrant (if there was one). Because of this gross breach of the American system, the local sheriff is now the subject of concern. The agent in charge alluded to this when he stated that the Davidians were being denied legal council because of the extreme circumstances. He stated that the supreme court supports this theory. The proper serving of a warrant is integral to the legal council process. But again, because of pressure applied by the radio talk show and local commentaries, Mr. Deguerin, who is the Koresh family attorney, was allowed to make contact with David Koresh.

A group of Christian ministers determined that we should visit the Waco area to evaluate the reports being published by the national news media. It was agreed that I would go to Waco representing both Scriptures for America and Christian Crusade for Truth. I would go to determine the demeanor of both the citizens of Waco and the Federal officials present.

We first went to the Waco Conference Center for the 10 AM daily briefing. We were denied entrance to the briefing because we lacked press credentials. There were quite a few people milling around outside the center with city police abundantly present. In talking to them it was clear that, "We are just doing our job. It's them against us and we are the thin blue line that keeps you people from killing each other."

One of the incensed Waco citizens provided us with extracts of the Texas State Penal Code, which the people of the area consider appropriate in this instance. The Texas State Penal Code is very specific as to the rights of an individual in resisting arrest. Subchapter C. Protection of Persons, Section 9.31 reads in part: "(c) the use of force to resist an arrest or search is justified: (1) if, before the actor offers any resistance, the peace officer (or person acting at his direction) uses or attempts to use greater force than necessary to make the arrest or search; and (2) when and to the degree the actor reasonably believes the force is immediately necessary to protect himself against the peace officer's (or other person's) use or attempted use of greater force than necessary."

A very interesting and enlightening incident occurred on that same day (which was released by the Associated Press News Service). Mr. Louis Beam, acting in the capacity of reporter for the Jubilee newspaper, a Christian publication located in Midpines, California, possessed the appropriate press credentials and entered the conference room. He listened

to the questions and answers given while awaiting his turn to ask his question. His statement and question, as reported by the AP with the audiotape of the radio broadcast concurring, was: "The people in this country are upset with the media because they're not asking what really matters here. The tactics being used here are very similar to those used both in Nazi Germany and the Soviet Union by the KGB. As you know there is much talk in the country about that." Then directing his question to the ATF Associate Director Dan Conroy, he asked: "Are we seeing the emergence of a police state in the United States?" The ATF agent responded by saying, "I won't even address answering that question." Mr. Conroy did not deny the question nor agree.

Police and sheriff deputies immediately surrounded Mr. Beam, demanding his credentials, the press pass and his drivers license. He was told to go with them to a back room. Mr. Bean refused and asked, "Are you arresting me, denying me my civil rights?" They said, "No" at which time Beam said he was leaving and they could mail him his credentials. The television cameras by this time were all around him. They followed him out the door but as Beam was leaving through the door, the sheriff's deputy rushed up and gave him back his credentials. When outside, the television reporters interviewed him and again Mr. Beam stated that they weren't asking tough enough questions. At least one of the reporters smiled and very faintly nodded affirmatively.

After leaving the conference, Mr. Beam stated that he wanted to go to the road blocks to determine if he could get into the inner road block where the press is allowed. Several of us went with him to witness and to also ask questions. The ATF quickly stopped Mr. Beam. Later he said that they immediately began to verbally insult him. Beam quickly moved over to be close to the Texas Ranger knowing he would provide him physical safety. Knowing this, the ATF agents told him to follow them to the inner road block where the press is located. They didn't take him to the inner road block. They stopped several hundred yards down the road and out of sight of the outer road block. According to Beam, at this point they verbally insulted and assaulted him, not only for his actions at the Waco Convention Center but also for his presence at the Randy Weaver incident in Idaho. The story doesn't stop here!

While we were at the roadblock, the demeanor of all of the police present was evaluated by the several well qualified men in my car. It was agreed that the Texas Rangers were gentlemen, not only in their looks but in the courtesy and manners they displayed. They were a credit to the people of Texas. The ATF agents didn't display the same manners. Many looked too young to vote. Some wore peculiar haircuts. Ron Engleman concurred with that assessment on his radio program. The most important observation was that they gave the strong impression that they were marching to a different drummer. They had the look of being psychologically profiled and programmed. One man on the radio stated that the dictionary definition of their looks and actions is the word myrmidon meaning "an unquestioning follower or subordinate who carries out orders without scruple or hesitation."

The following week Mr. Beam returned to the daily news conference with his press pass. When the Waco police saw him coming they encircled him and told him he couldn't enter. Beam told them he was going in or they could arrest him. They did! When taken to the magistrate he was asked why they threw him out the week before. He said it was for telling them the press was asking the wrong questions! The magistrate agreed and released Mr. Beam on his own personal recognizance! Americans are beginning to understand!

The average person in the Waco area believes that this incident at the Davidian complex is more than a matter of simple weapons violations. They believe that David Koresh and the men and women under siege are standing for the freedoms of the American people. Person after person interviewed believed that the U.S. government acted in a manner that places

shame on the American system. Many expressed the opinion that our country is facing a major confrontation.

Because the government at all levels denied the civil rights of Louis Beam at the Waco Convention Center, there has been a \$350,000 Biven's Action Civil Rights Suit filed in the Federal Courts. The plaintiffs are reporter Louis Beam and the Jubilee newspaper publisher Paul Hall. The named defendants are the United States of America, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms and the individual officers involved including the Sergeant of the Waco City Police who arrested Mr. Beam. The serving of the suit was denied at the Waco Federal Building but was accepted at the next higher court in San Antonio, Texas. This will be a very important case in the Christian Patriot movement. The American people should be watching this case to see if everyone is equal in the eyes of the law or if some are more equal than others!

As of this writing, the standoff at the Davidian complex continues. If circumstances permit and because of its importance, we will continue with additional information in the next issue. Because of space limitations, we must continue with the esoteric reasons for the ATF assault on the Branch Davidian church.

The esoteric background on the assault on the Branch Davidian complex. Why did the ATF assault the complex at Waco and what is the history behind it? Is this an isolated case or can we include most of the other ATF raids in the same category? What did the cases concerning Gordon Kahl, Arthur Kirk, John Singer, Randy Weaver, Maynard Campbell, the Knudson family and a host of others, have in common with the Branch Davidians? The recent seige of the LaPorte Church of Christ and the confiscation of private property by the State of Colorado can be included in the group as being singled out for the same purpose.

All of these people and groups have been classified as belonging to cults. But it is not just any cult, it must be a certain type of cult. There is the cult of Isis, the Bohemian Grove cult, the New Age cult, the Satanic cult, the Homosexual cult, the National Organization of Women cult, the cult of Freemasonry, the New Africa cult, the Brown Berets cult, the Aztlan cult and a host of others. Some of these believe in stockpiling weapons and have even been known to use them. None of these qualify for raids.

What, then, makes certain so called cults, or members thereof, vulnerable? Simply, one must be a member of a group that has been singled out by the [Cult Awareness Network](#) (CAN). What is the Cult Awareness Network and where did it come from? To answer that question we must go back in history and, once again, it all seems to originate at the same source.

Many of the Lessons in History have discussed the CABAL in England at the time of Oliver Cromwell and the combining of forces between the royalty of England and the finances of the Jewish International Bankers. It was agreed that between them they would rule the world. As secular history proves, they did just that and the world heard of such phrases as, "Rule Britannia" and "The sun never sets on the British Empire." The coalition between the money and the royalty has always been a curious phenomenon. Each thought they were in complete control of the other! The royalty considered their Jewish bankers and advisors as their Hofjuden or Court Jews. The Jews didn't care because they were people of the world with allegiance only to their own people. They were a "government within a government." Their power came from their money. Of course, the phrase that one should really hear is "the sun never sets on the graves of the British boys who died creating the empire."

As history has been seen through revisionism, the world should now realize that the "privileged class" gained the wealth for that empire through such organizations as the British East Indies Company. The Chinese opium trade is but one example.

During the rise to power of that coalition in England, the royalty became more and more involved in the Cabala and the occult. The secret societies were developed, truly "marrying" the two peoples together. As the wealthy class became more involved in the occult and secret societies and had more time to spare for such things, they became fascinated with the human mind and how to control it. The source documents for this are so numerous that the bibliography for this lesson will simply list a number of them for your own study.

The power of the British Commonwealth began to wane in the 19th century. When a group starts to trust and believe in their secret society and their occult more than in God and His principles, it is a promise that they will fail. When the elite of the British Empire realized their plight, they turned more to the tools they had learned in the occult in an attempt to regain that power.

Past Lessons in History have discussed the efforts of Lord Palmerston, the Earl of Shaftsbury, Lawrence Oliphant, Benjamin Disraeli, Theodore Hertzl and a host of others. It was shown that these men were but a continuation of the earlier efforts of Psycho-Politics. Lord Palmerston's estate is considered the birthplace of the modern concept of Psychological Warfare. However, the aristocracy (English and Jewish) had already developed a major political secret intelligence operation using the Black Nobility (Guelphs), Knights of St. John Of Jerusalem and the Scottish Rite of Freemasonry. Lord Palmerston was one of the leading Knights Of St. John, a Mason and was deeply involved in the Chinese opium trade. It was from the psycho-politics developed at Palmerston's estate that much of the direction of the U.S. Civil War and the development of the use of environmental concerns for political purposes took place.

Cecil Rhodes realized that the British Empire was falling apart. He, along with Carnegie, Lord Milner and others, organized another "secret society" to rebuild the British Empire and his plans were to regain the United States. That "secret society" manifested itself in the [Royal Institute of International Affairs](#) (RIIA) in 1919. Its known purpose was to use psycho-politics and the forced submission of the human mind to their will. Sounds crazy, doesn't it? Well, they meant it and they have greatly succeeded.

To pay for this massive effort, another "opium war" would be launched, this time against the United States! It commenced within one year after the RIIA was founded, in 1920, and it was called the prohibition amendment here in the U.S. Prohibition brought us organized crime, narcotics, general decadence and wealth to many families such as the Bronfmans and the Kennedys. It also brought us what became known as the Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms (ATF) and the first restrictive gun laws in the United States, in direct defiance of the Second Amendment. Why have we used only the letters ATF in this lesson? Why are only the letters ATF on the back of the jackets of these agents? It is most important for us to know that in 1981 the budget reorganization imposed by the Reagan Administration eliminated the bureau and its function! If that is the case, what is the ATF and to whom does it report?

Moral prostitutes on this side of the Atlantic joined the parade, which started in England. The Eastern Establishment Anglophiles became wealthier than they already were on the coattails of the Royal Institute Of International Affairs. The United States became involved with the RIIA officially with the development of the Office of Strategic Services (OSS). The OSS later became known as the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), which is split into two functions, the covert and the overt. It is in the covert operations that will be of interest.

Along with the RIIA, another organization was founded, the Tavistock Institute in London. Its purpose was to accomplish the networking of the myriad of smaller organizations in Europe, England and the United States which would use communism, cults, drugs, homosexuality, occults, public education, etc., to reduce the human mind to that of an animal.

With that brief background we now can describe the Cult Awareness Network (CAN) and its relationship, not only to the Waco incident but to most of the other sieges and arrests that have been accomplished against selected groups and individuals in recent years. The current Executive Director is Cynthia Kissler, who was reported to be, previously, a topless dancer at the Blue Note Lounge in Tucson, Arizona!

The parent organization for CAN is the Tavistock Institute. In the United States the CAN effort is funded by several Anglophile endowment foundations. The Bodman Foundation, the Swig Foundation, the Scaife Foundation and the Achellis Foundation are principal donors. The legal services for the Cult Awareness Network is provided by two very prestigious law firms, Morris and McVeigh. Melvin Swig was a national commission member of the ADL and a national executive board member of the American Israel Political Affairs Committee (AIPAC).

The Bodman Foundation also financed the Temple of Understanding which is the only religious chapel in the United Nations building. The Temple of Understanding is a creation of the Lucis Trust which was originally called the Lucifer Trust. The offices of the Temple of Understanding are in the Anglican Church of St. John the Divine in New York City. The Bodman Trust funds that church also.

Responsible for the foundation funds and providing a "mother" organization is the American Family Foundation (AFF). The American Family Foundation and the Cult Awareness Network are housed in the Washington D.C. headquarters of the B'nai-B'rith! The money, political power and the Anglophile family ties of the above organizations provide the interface to the United States Government. There can be no dispute that when an individual from any one of the above organizations places a telephone call to anyone in the government of the United States, the response is always, "Yes, sir" or "No, sir!"

With that in mind, the relationship between those organizations and the Department of Justice, the Central Intelligence Agency, the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Department of Treasury is very cordial.

The intelligence gathering and enforcement arm of the B'nai- B'rith is the Anti Defamation League (ADL). Funding for the Cult Awareness Network comes down from the foundations to the American Family Foundation, through the Anti Defamation League to the Cult Awareness Network. Another integral part to the direction of the Cult Awareness Network is the American Jewish Committee and the Jewish Community Relations Council's Taskforce on Missionaries and Cults. The ADL also accomplishes networking between the Cult Awareness Network and other organizations responding to the ideals of the Tavistock Institute. Thus, many individuals have been known to move from one organization to another as needs and opportunities arose.

The Cult Awareness Network hires a number of psychiatrists, security specialists (kidnappers), and so-called "deprogrammers." After a considerable number of briefings between the government and the American Family Foundation network which includes, "intelligence data" provided by the ADL, "psychological profiles" provided by the CAN psychiatrists and the tactical plans provided by the CAN "security specialists," it is decided to "rescue" selected people from selected so-called cults. CAN "security specialists" brag of actually kidnapping hundreds of members of selected organizations. At the 1992 national

convention of CAN, their kidnappers and deprogrammers boasted of over 1800 kidnappings with a 95% success rate for deprogramming. Once a person is kidnapped, a complex deprogramming takes place by the psychiatrists. If the selected person can actually be deprogrammed, he is then reprogrammed into believing what CAN wants them to believe. That person is then used to provide suitable "witness" material to the appropriate law officers of the country.

Their work is made much easier for them if the organization called a cult has a member or members whose families vehemently disagree with the beliefs of the organization. In this case, the family members will even pay the expenses for the kidnapping and deprogramming, even though the ADL and the foundations already have funded the operation. Thousands of dollars exchange hands in this manner.

Not all organizations or families can be penetrated and in some cases they don't need to be. For example, Arthur Kirk was too, determined to be deprogrammed. He was a suitable candidate to put fear in the hearts of those farmers who were active in the Kansas and Nebraska farmers' rebellion against foreclosures, which they knew were orchestrated by the grain cartels. But, Arthur Kirk was psychologically profiled. The rest is history.

Gordon Kahl was a determined man. He was speaking out on the drug cartel in North Dakota. Investigations have proven this point. No psychiatrist could have deprogrammed Gordon. The rest is history.

The Randy Weaver family is another example where they couldn't be penetrated for deprogramming. There wasn't a person in that family who was not sufficiently determined to remain true to their principles. It was Vicki Weaver who was psychologically profiled. The rest is history.

The opening remarks at the trial of Randy Weaver and Kevin Harris on April 13, 1993 tells us why the Weaver family was selected and now that we understand what and who the Cult Awareness Network is, we can understand who directs the United States Government to make these sieges. An article found in the *Seattle Post-Intelligencer* quotes both Gerry Spence, Weaver's defense attorney, and federal prosecutor Ronald Howen.

Defense attorney Spence was quoted, "If the prosecution is allowed to use Weaver's beliefs against him, it will need to do nothing more than prove that this defendant is a bad man, a demon who must be destroyed. It's a conspiracy to have a family, it's a conspiracy to grow a garden, it's a conspiracy to worship God in the way they see fit." The article stated, "As Spence argued passionately to bar any mention of his client's beliefs when the case goes to trial, Howen (federal prosecutor-ed.) repeatedly interrupted to object to what he called the lawyer's pure theatrics for the public and the press here."

The federal prosecutor, Ronald Howen, was quoted as saying, "Did Weaver deliberately provoke a bloody confrontation at his north Idaho mountaintop cabin in August, causing three deaths, to carry out his vision of an apocalyptic battle with federal agents of what he called the `Zionist Occupation Government?' Weaver's beliefs are inextricably intertwined into the case...because of their belief in Armageddon, in the Great Tribulation."

The Weavers were selected by the same people who selected the Branch Davidians. The Weaver's were selected because of their religious beliefs and their beliefs in a great battle that is rapidly coming into view.

What other beliefs the Weavers and the Branch Davidians have, or do not have, in common is immaterial. Both have strong religious convictions and both believe in a great battle that the entire world senses to be in the near future.

The article also revealed another very important point. It stated that federal Judge Lodge refused to reveal the identity and background of the undercover informant who bought the two sawed-off shotguns from Weaver in 1991. The government has given the defense only the false identity used by the informant. Whoever this informant is, he could be a deprogrammed and reprogrammed former associate of Randy Weaver.

Now for the relationship between CAN and the Branch Davidians of Waco, Texas. Margaret Singer, a CAN psychologist, along with Priscilla Coates (a former CAN director) are presently in Waco and have access to the law enforcement field offices located there.

Margaret Singer's background is most interesting. She was an army psychiatrist who studied veterans from the Korean and Vietnam Wars. She is known to have worked with Dr. Edgar Schein and Dr. Albert Biderman, both of whom were active in the CIA MK- Ultra programs. This is the infamous LSD experimentation within the military as a means to alter the human mind. The connection with the Royal Institute of International Affairs and the Tavistock Institute is obvious. She was also involved with the New Religions Movement at the Graduate Theological Seminary at Berkeley, California.

About one year ago, Rick Ross, a deprogrammer (read kidnapper) for CAN went to Waco to kidnap a potential candidate. Rick Ross successfully kidnapped one of the members and successfully deprogrammed him after taking him to the home of Priscilla Coates in California. After being reprogrammed to say what they wanted him to, the victim allegedly began accusing the Davidian complex of weapons violations, child abuse, immorality, and authoritarian excesses by David Koresh. He was taken to the ATF and discussed his accusations with them. Ross's kidnapping took place about one year ago, just about right for the planning, the building of the replica in Arkansas and making the assault at Waco. And so it goes.
