**SHOT FIRED DURING ATTEMPTED ARMED ROBBERY
IN ROOSEVELT FIELD MALL**

December 22, 2015; approximately 1:00 PM

A man walked up to the Rolex case in a watch store and attempted to rob the store. When he tried to leave he was stopped by a store security guard. As the guard scuffled with the robber, the robber's gun discharged. A mall employee standing out in the hallway was injured by the bullet. Mall security and an off-duty NYPD officer helped subdue the gunman and remove his weapon. The gunman was taken into custody by the Nassau County Police.

The suspect in custody has been identified as Oliver Lee, 21, of Douglaston, Queens.

Loss Prevention Reminders:

1. Do not resist an armed robber.
2. Be sure you have properly functioning CCTV with recording and off-site storage of the data.
3. During this holiday season it is important to have sufficient staff and for everyone to be trained to be vigilant to potential thieves and robbers.
