

Stanislaus Service Center Council Golden Bell and State "WHO" Award

The Golden Bell/State WHO Award is an honor bestowed each year on one teacher/leader within the Stanislaus Service Center Council whose service to peers, public education, and the teaching profession is exemplary. This award provides acknowledgement of that teacher/leader who has served not only his/her chapter, but has extended this service as an advocate for quality education, teacher rights, professional working conditions, and teacher empowerment in an extensive, encompassing manner.

Nominees for this award must demonstrate a broad spectrum of service to public education. **Their service must extend beyond the chapter level and include active participation in service to teachers and public education at a variety of levels.** Service in such capacities as having served on Service Center Council as a steering committee member or officer; NEA-RA representative; State Council representative; Presenter for New Teacher Class; Presenter for Good Teaching Conference; CTA Advisory Committee member; Coordinated Bargaining representative; Regional/State Educational Task Force member are all representative examples of the types of extended service performed by teachers who are nominated for this award.
