STATE OF THE TOWNSHIP

In 2019: We experienced \$2,088,000 worth of new construction.

Bought a new utility tractor for the cemetery and park. This purchase has helped the sexton greatly.

Used calcium chloride for dust control. It seems to last longer than brine.

Unexpectedly had to buy a new lawnmower in August.

Applied crushed limestone to P3 Lane.

In October, we accepted a bid for the new pavilion and equipment for the park. We were not able to start construction last fall, but, everything is set to begin this Spring as soon as breakup is done. I feel the pavilion will be a great addition to our park and will be used a lot.

Since this is my last State of the Township report, I would like to reflect a little on the last 14 years I have served as Supervisor of Menominee Township. The time has flown by, but when I look back at where I started and to where we are now, I think I can say we have come a long way forward.

We have a nice Roadside Park, a well-housed and equipped Fire Department. We have spent literally millions of dollars on our roads. And we have greatly improved our park to the benefit of our township residents and others. I did not do this alone. I have had good people who have served with me that were able to put the interest of the township ahead of their own personal wishes. And that is basically what it takes to have a good local government.
