A Note From Rick: Tuesday's markets were a little softer in all categories. The hay market was a bit easier for the first time in a long while. We had a bigger selection of hay than we've had recently, but still not the volume of past years. We had a larger than normal dairy sale for a Tuesday and prices were sluggish as well. The special feeder sale wasn't quite as big as most months are and prices were a little weaker. Slaughter cows weren't able to continue their slow progress of late as prices fell \$2-\$4 compared to a week ago. We were very pleased with our first annual Standardbred Trotting Breeder's Edition Auction on Saturday. The sale offered an excellent group of weanlings, yearlings and broodmares. We had a great turnout on Saturday and horses sold very well overall. The overall average was \$6,788 with the top seller bringing \$33,000. Yearlings averaged \$5,879 with the top yearling bringing \$19,000. Broodmares averaged \$9,692 with the top 2 mares bringing over \$30,000. We'd like to thank the buyers and consignors for their support and we look forward to this sale again next year. We are looking forward to rounding out 2020 with the Miller Yoder Christmas Standardbred Trotting sale before Christmas. Hope to see you at TLA!
