• **OPEN TO EVERYONE.**

• **ENTRY FEE:** Submit one to three pieces of your original artwork for a total of \$25.

• **COMPLETE THE ENTRY FORM BELOW.** Also complete the labels on the reverse side of this form and firmly attach a label to the back of each of your pieces of art. Place your entry form and payment in an envelope and adhere that to your artwork. No need to mail anything to CBAC.

• **PHOTOGRAPH YOUR ART FOR THE VIRTUAL TOUR OF THE SHOW.** Before you frame your artwork under glass, photograph it and send jpegs to washburnculturalcenter@gmail.com by Sun., April 4. The virtual tour will appear on the WCC and CBAC websites.

• **DELIVER YOUR ARTWORK** (*no appointment needed*) to the Washburn Museum and Cultural Center (1 E. Bayfield St., Washburn, WI) on April 1 or 2 between 1 p.m. and 5 p.m.

You may pick up artwork on April 29 or 30 between 12 and 4 p.m.

• **AT LEAST ONE OF YOUR ENTRIES MUST BE OFFERED FOR SALE.** All artwork must have been completed within the last year.

• The Washburn Cultural Center will withhold a **30% COMMISSION** for any artwork sold during the exhibition. Please consider this when pricing your work. **YOU WILL RECEIVE 70% OF THE SALE PRICE.**

• 2-dimensional artwork must be dry, framed, and ready to hang, with screw eyes and wires to correspond with the weight of the artwork. Sawtooth hangers or extremely fragile work will not be accepted.

• 3-dimensional artwork, such as sculpture, ceramics, or carvings must be stable for pedestals or shelf installation. For large or unusual entries, the artist must provide appropriate display units.

• The Cultural Center will be responsible for the day-to-day safekeeping of the artwork, but does not carry insurance on the artwork. Artists are responsible for insuring their own works.

• **NO RECEPTION** due to Covid, but Ron Piercy from Karlyn's Yellowbird Gallery will be awarding **THREE MONETARY PRIZES. A PRIZE OF ART SUPPLIES** from Karlyn's Yellowbird Gallery will be awarded to the Audience Choice winner.

• **THE EXHIBIT CAN BE VIEWED** at the Washburn Cultural Center beginning April 7, Wednesday through Sunday between 12 and 4 p.m.
