Our conference has promoted access to mental health prevention and treatment services by offering opportunities for education, advocacy and networking.

This year's SEEDS conference will be held at Glendale Community College on May 22nd, 2019 with an optional Adult/Youth Mental Health First Aid Training taking place on May 23rd, 2019. Our theme #NextGen:B4STAGE4 will build collaborative partnerships that promote the mental health, resilience and self-determination of young adults. We hope to provide parents, caregivers, professionals and young adults with advocacy strategies to navigate the criminal justice and behavioral health system; highlighting the importance of mental health screenings for early identification and intervention. Last year the SEEDS Conference brought over 215 participants. We are planning for an even larger crowd this year, with 2 keynote speakers, 24 breakout sessions, a town hall listening session and a first ever networking reception! MHA AZ cannot do this alone, especially as we hope to provide a low-cost, perhaps free, means to attend for as many family members, young adults and people with lived experience as possible.
