Hebrews 11 :23-27 (NIV): Vs: 23-25: *"By faith Moses' parents hid him for three months after he was born, because they saw he was no ordinary child. They were not afraid of the king's edict. By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter. He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than enjoy the pleasures of sin for a short time."*

Vs: 26-27: *"He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as a greater value than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward. By faith, he left Egypt, not fearing the king's anger; he persevered because he saw him who is invisible."*

### KNOWING MY GOD GIVEN TRUE IDENTITY ...

#### 1. It demonstrates **My Spiritual Maturity**

v. 24: *"By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter."*

John 8:14a (NIV): *Jesus answered, "Even if I testify on my own behalf, my testimony is valid, for I know where I came from and where I am going ..."*

#### 2. It brings into focus **My Responsibility**

v. 25: *"He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a short time."*

#### 3. It establishes **My Priority**

Hebrews 11 :26 (NIV): *"He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward."*

### What were Moses' values?

- **FULFILING GOD’S PURPOSE** was better than popularity. (v. 24)
- **LOVING GOD’S PEOPLE** was than pleasure. (v.25)
- **HAVING GOD’S PEACE** was than possessions. (v. 25)

Philippians 3:8 *"What is more, I consider everything a loss compared to the surpassing greatness of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them rubbish, that I may I may gain Christ"*

4. It brings to light **MY DESTINY**" Hebrews 11 (NIV): *"By faith he left Egypt, not fearing the king's anger; he persevered because saw him who is invisible*

2 Corinthian 5:17 (NIV) "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation: the old has gone, the new has come.
