The slaughter market was steady and still hasn't fully rebounded from the drop off of prices a month or so ago, but I look for this to possibly happen soon with farmers going to the fields and numbers of cattle on the market shortening up. Thursday's springer sale was a dandy. We had a big run of heifers and the market was steady to stronger which has been the case for 5 months in a row, in my opinion. This is a win-win situation because these prices are still very reasonable from a buyers standpoint compared to the slaughter market. The only other thing that sticks out in my mind this week is the fact that the really good cattle are selling better but medium to lower quality or underfed cattle are not and this is the case with all of our markets.
