
¿Las próximas pláticas Bautismales?

Gracias a todos que regularmente y generosamente contribuyan al colecta ofertorio durante nuestras Misas al fin de la semana. El reto del presupuesto parroquial por este nuevo año fiscal (a partir de 1 de julio) es \$3,026 semanalmente.

De vez en cuando damos cuenta que hay tres pasos espirituales en cuanto de la manera de contribuir a su parroquia:

- 1) rezar en la presencia de Cristo Jesús pidiéndole luz de cuanto dinero donar
- 2) calcular la proporción de su ingreso a compartir con su iglesia cada mes y
- 3) planificar a ponerla en la colecta ofertorio semanalmente.

Con este método, se evita el capricho de echar unos pocos dólares al canasto los cuales no ayudan mucho a su iglesia de Santa María a pagar sus gastos, inclusive por los luces, aire condicionado, mantenimiento del plantel, etc.

Finalmente, además de los padres de familia, es buena formación religiosa y disciplina personal que los jóvenes y aun niños acostumbrarse a donar algo a su parroquia semanalmente.



Are you Safe Environment trained?



VIRTUS is a program encouraged by Bishops nation wide to train adults, clergy included on promoting safe environment for

children and youth. Virtus training of adults is required for Safe Environment Compliance particularly for any adult who will come into contact with children or youth as part of their ministry. It must be completed before they begin ministry (a listing of those ministries can be found at <http://bit.ly/1yU4Yk6>).

On Saturday, August 26, our parish VIRTUS coordinator, Ron Akerman, will offer a training session for adult parishioners (18 years of age and older). Adult parishioners who are not currently volunteers are encouraged to attend this training to inform themselves of dangers in our society to children and youth and to provide themselves with tools they can use to help keep safe children and youth. - + love for the Church; communion with pastors;
- + an apostolic spirit... love for their brothers and sisters and a willingness to give generous service;
- + sufficient education (able to follow a lesson plan)
- + the respect of their parish community;
- + the human, moral and technical qualities necessary for the work of a catechist, such as dynamism and good relations with others;

Notice The New Weekly Budget Figure?



Our new fiscal year weekly budget figure for our parish's weekend offertory collections averages \$3,026 as compared to \$2,588 for the FY just ended 6/30/17. The weekly increase of \$438 over

last year FY is due in great part to the needed hiring of a reliable person with expertise for book-keeping and the long overdue painting of the exterior of the church and hall (\$8,700). The relatively small \$438 figure would have been higher were it not for successful measures taken last year and before to decrease the cost of utilities (\$7,000), household expenses (\$7,000), and office expenses (\$2,800).
