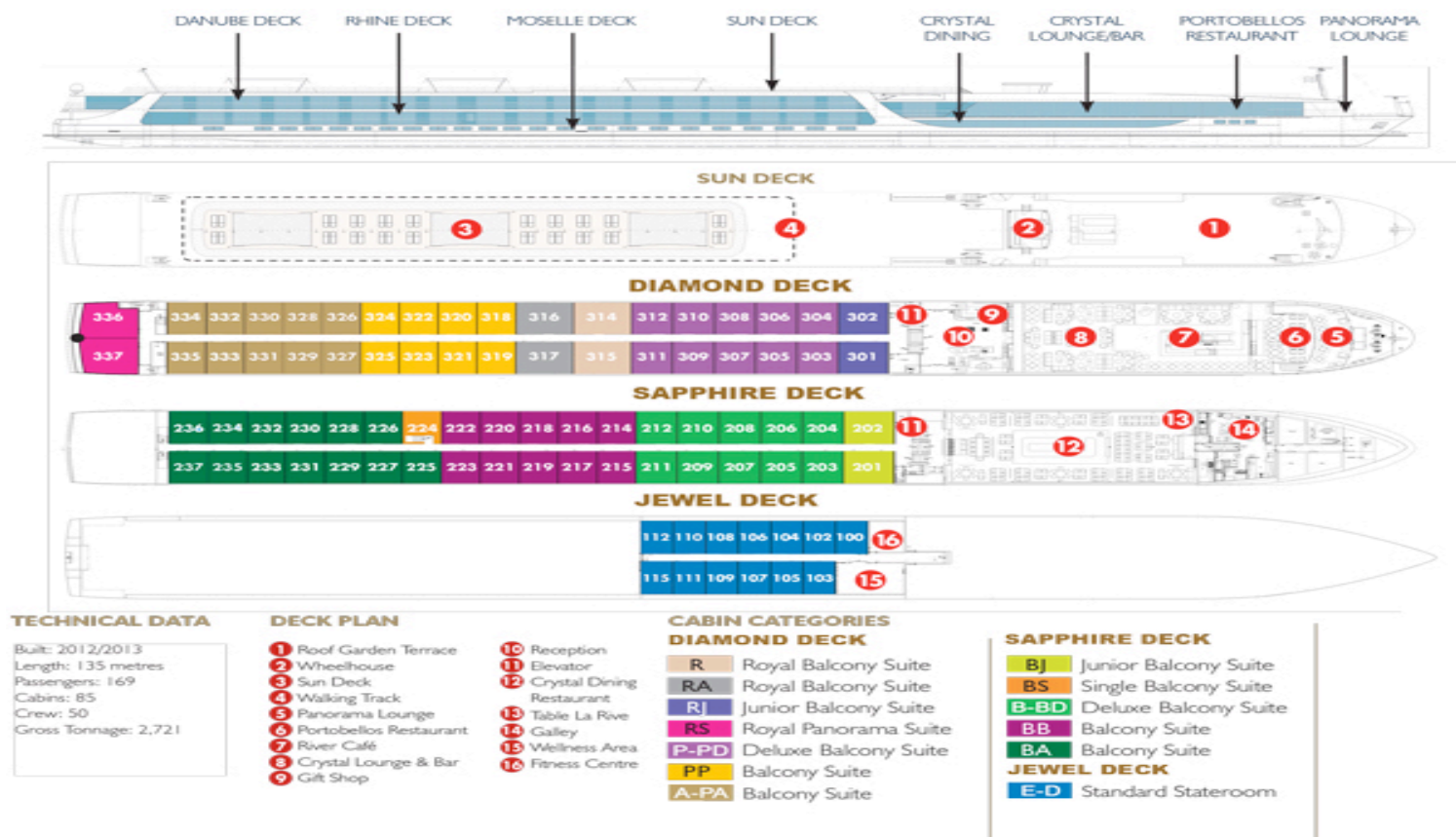

Itinerary (subject to change / approval from cruise company)

Day 1: Tuesday October 20, 2015 - Depart the USA: Depart Los Angeles (LAX) for Budapest, Hungary.

Day 2 Wednesday October 21, 2015: Arrive Budapest. Welcome to Budapest, one of Eastern Europe's most ancient cities. On arrival at the airport, you will be met by a Jet Vacations representative and transferred* to your deluxe Scenic cruise ship in Budapest. Here, you will have the chance to unpack, relax in your room and explore all of the ship's fantastic facilities. This evening, you have a special invitation to a Cocktail Reception and Welcome Dinner where you will meet other guests, crew and the captain, and acquaint yourself with life on the river. Included meals: Welcome Dinner.

Day 3 Thursday October 22, 2015: Budapest - Bratislava. Widely known as one of the continent's most beautiful and cosmopolitan cities, Budapest is home to many UNESCO World Heritage Sites, including the Buda Castle Quarter, Andrassy Avenue, Heroes' Square and the Millennium Underground Railway – the second oldest railway in the world. Today, your private guided tour takes you past the Royal Palace of Buda – home to the Hungarian National Gallery, Budapest History Museum, the National Library, Lion Courtyard, Matthias Well, and the statue of the Turul Bird, the mythological bird of the Magyars. The tour then continues to Fisherman's Bastion, situated on Castle Hill, where you can admire the most breathtaking panoramic views of the city, before moving on to see Matthias Church and the iconic Chain Bridge. As one of Budapest's most symbolic landmarks, the Chain Bridge, designed by English engineer William Tierney Clark, links Buda and Pest, and was considered one of the world's engineering marvels at the time of construction. Enjoy dinner onboard and in the evening, sail for Bratislava. As we leave Budapest you will have a chance to see Budapest landmarks such as The Chain Link Bridge and Parliament illuminated at night, a breathtaking sight. Included excursions: a guided tour of Budapest. Included meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner.

Day 4 Friday October 23, 2015: Bratislava - Vienna. Wake up this morning in Bratislava, capital of the Slovak Republic. Today you will experience the bustling pedestrian plazas and stylish street cafés of Bratislava. And for a more profound insight, you will tour Old Town, home to a plethora of historical buildings. Highlights will include the including the Old Town Hall, the stunning Mirbach Palace and Gothic St. Martin's Cathedral. Here, you will also find Bratislava's Town Hall, a complex of three buildings erected in the 14th and 15th centuries, Michael's Gate, one of the oldest of the town's structures, and nearby, the narrowest house in Europe. Afterwards, enjoy a special home-hosted afternoon tea with a local Slovakian family, providing you with a truly authentic insight into Slovakian culture. Once you have been welcomed into their home, feast on traditional fare in the company of new friends, and discover what everyday life is like in Slovakia's largest city. Later, board the ship and cruise the Danube enroute to Vienna. Evening in Vienna on your own. SPECIAL FEATURE: A home-hosted afternoon tea with a local Slovakian family. Included excursions: a sightseeing tour of Bratislava. Included meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 5 Saturday October 24, 2015: Vienna. Austria's vibrant city of Vienna is a fantastic fusion of old and new. As well as being known as 'The City of Music' because of its musical legacy, Vienna is also regarded as 'The City of Dreams' as it was home to Sigmund Freud, the world's first psychoanalyst. Today, we take you on an icon-filled coach tour along the Ringstrasse where you will see Vienna's world-famous Opera House, Burgtheatre, Town Hall and Hofburg Imperial Palace, before hopping off to explore by foot. This afternoon, you are free to explore this magnificent city, which is home to over 27 castles and an astonishing 150 palaces. For an unforgettable view of Vienna, enjoy a ride on the Riesenrad, the main square's giant ferris wheel. From its dizzying heights, you'll be able to take in the city's fabulous sights from a truly unique vantage point. Visit St. Stephen's Cathedral with its 18 amazing authentic altars, the tomb of Emperor Frederick III, and the Maria Pötsch Icon, a Byzantine-style icon of St. Mary with the child Jesus. Alternatively, you may choose this afternoon to join an optional visit to Schönbrunn Palace – Empress Sisi's former summer residence - complete with an enchanting park, zoo and labyrinth. And in the evening, you can also book an optional trip to watch a Viennese concert. Included excursions: a sightseeing drive along the Ringstrasse and a walking tour of Vienna. Included meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 6 Sunday October 25, 2015: Dürnstein – Melk Abbey In the morning, sail through the great Wachau Valley and arrive in Dürnstein, where you will have time to explore this lovely town on your own. You will marvel at the magnificent blue façade of the baroque Stiftskirche. Above town you'll spot the ruins of the castle where Richard the Lionheart, King of England, was imprisoned in 1192. Your walking tour through medieval cobblestone streets reveals 16th-century town houses and wine taverns. Afterwards, you will return to the ship and set sail to Melk Abbey, the famous 900-year old Benedictine Abbey, one of Europe's largest baroque monasteries, located above the town on a splendid rocky outcrop, overlooking where the Danube joins the picturesque Wachau Valley. Melk Abbey boasts the finest Italian architecture, elaborate gold leaf walls, a 640-foot Imperial Corridor and fabulous fresco ceilings. Enjoy an organ concert in the abbey. SPECIAL FEATURE: a guided tour of Melk Abbey including an organ concert. Included excursions: a guided tour of Dürnstein. Included meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 7 Monday October 26, 2015: Passau. Arrive in Passau and disembark for a guided city tour which takes you on an in-depth exploration of this fairy-tale city founded more than 2,000 years ago. Situated at the confluence of the rivers Danube, Inn and Ilz, Passau is known worldwide as "The Three Rivers City". On this morning's walking tour, stroll through the cobblestone streets and narrow alleys before emerging to find the perfect view of the hilltop Oberhaus Fortress. Originally designed to serve the Bishop of Passau in 1219, it is today home to a fascinating museum, restaurant and open-air theatre. On this day, as a substitution for the Passau excursion, you will be able to take an optional tour to Salzburg, the birthplace of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. If you have seen the movie The Sound of Music, you may already be familiar with Salzburg, though nothing surpasses experiencing this picturesque Austrian city firsthand. Admittedly, it is difficult not to burst into song when you're walking along the Salzach River, or climbing up to the Hohensalzburg fortress, which looms over the city, but there is a lot more to this compact, courtly city than the Julie Andrews film. Included excursions: a walking tour of Passau. SPECIAL FEATURE: evening entertainment with a traditional Bavarian Oompah Band. Included meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 8 Tuesday October 27, 2015: Weltenburg – Regensburg. On today's agenda is a relaxing sail along the delightful Danube Gorge, which carves through magnificent 300-foot cliffs before reaching Weltenburg Abbey. Founded by monks in 602 AD, Weltenburg Abbey is the oldest monastery in Bavaria and today boasts a courtyard surrounded by Baroque buildings. After exploring this ancient church and its grounds, you will have the chance to sample Weltenburg's famous dark beer before returning to your ship and sailing on to Regensburg. Here, you will take a guided tour of Germany's best-preserved medieval city, where architectural highlights include the Old Town Hall and the Old Stone Bridge, one of the oldest bridges crossing the Danube. This evening, you have a special invitation to the Captain's Gala Dinner, where you will join your fellow guests. Included excursions: a guided tour of Weltenburg Abbey and Regensburg. Included meals: breakfast, lunch and Captain's Gala Dinner.

Day 9: Wednesday October 28, 2015 - Nuremberg (FB): This morning you will be transferred* by your Jet Vacations representative to Munich Airport for your onward or homebound flight or to your 3-night optional extension to Prague. Included meals: breakfast. **END OF SERVICES**

Day 9: Wednesday October 28, 2015 – Nuremberg - Prague (FB): After breakfast experience a morning World War II* tour, which focuses on Nuremberg during the time of the Third Reich. Designated the City of the Reichsparteitage (Nazi Party Rallies), you will visit the Zeppelin Field where Hitler once held his Nazi rallies, the Colosseum, and the Justice Palace courtroom where the War Crimes Tribunal sat in 1946 (when available.) Museum visit on your own, then transfer by deluxe coach to your hotel in Prague.

Day 10: Thursday October 29, 2015 –Prague (FB): Breakfast – Full-day tour of Prague

Day 11: Friday October 30, 2015 – Prague (FB): Breakfast – Full day at leisure

Day 12: Saturday October 31, 2015 – Departure day (FB): After breakfast, pick up at your hotel in Prague and transfer to the Prague airport for your flight back to the US.

Cancellation Policies: No charges other than the non-refundable initial deposit are levied for individual passengers canceling up to 120 days prior to the commencement of Jet Vacations LLC services. However, services which have been prepaid by Jet Vacations LLC on behalf of individual clients maybe non-refundable, non-exchangeable, non changeable and/or maybe subject to a cancellation- change fee (e.g. theater tickets, Train tickets, Airline Tickets, Event Tickets, Passes, Entrance fees etc.).

Full cancellation: Failing to pay the contractual deposits (other than the initial deposit) constitutes a cancellation. In the

event of non-compliance with the payment due dates, Jet Vacations LLC shall have the right to demand the Customer to immediately pay the outstanding balance. Payment shall then be received by Jet Vacations LLC within eight days as of the date of Jet Vacations LLC's written request. Should payment not be received within this time limit, the group stay shall be deemed to be canceled by the Customer. In the event of full cancellation of the agreement by the Customer, which is not justified by Jet Vacations LLC's failure to meet its obligations, cancellation penalties shall be invoiced and calculated as follows:

Initial deposit**: non-refundable.

From 119 to 91 days prior to departure: 35% penalty of the total cost per person.

From 90 to 61 days prior to departure: 50% penalty of the total cost per person.

From 60 to 31 days prior to departure: 75% penalty of the total cost per person.

From 30 to day of departure & no show: 100% penalty of the total cost per person.

** 50% of the first deposit to hold the space is non refundable.

All subsequent deposits are non-refundable. If a passenger cancellation creates a change in the price schedule, the tour price will be revised based on the remaining number of participants. A passenger becoming a single as a result of a partner's cancellation must pay the single supplement.

NOTE: The following non-refundable fees will be added to the penalty charges listed on the cancellation (full or partial) schedule above: Travel protection premiums. Airline tickets - airline penalties, which may be up to 100% of the ticket

Itinerary variation: We will make every effort to operate all tours as advertised. Situations may arise, voluntarily or involuntarily, that require changes or exceptions in the airport of departure, the itinerary, land arrangements, hotels, trains or ports of call. On these occasions, we reserve the right to make such modifications and substitute conveyances/hotels as deemed necessary.

Minimum participants to Operate: Cruise needs a minimum of 100 participants to operate. Optional tours need a minimum of 20 participants to operate.
