ANSWERS FOR 15-MINUTE KIDS BIBLE STUDIES #21-30

KIDS BIBLE STUDY #21:

- 1. 40 days
- 2. For the promise of the Father (ESV)
- 3. You are baptized with the Holy Spirit.
- 4. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.
- 5. <u>Power!</u> (Look up power: G1411 in Strong's Concordance. 'Power' means 'miraculous power', 'might', 'worker of miracles', etc....)¹
- 6. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit.
- 7. They began to speak in other tongues. (This is the language of the Spirit, or praying in the Spirit.)

KIDS BIBLE STUDY #22:

- 1. Jesus
- 2. They did not believe all that the prophets had spoken in the Old Covenant scriptures.
- 3. True (Example: Isaiah 53, Isaiah 54, Isaiah 61, Psalm 103, Psalm 91, and many more.....)
- 4. Yes, God told them far in advance. (Example, Isaiah was written around 800 years before Jesus.)
- 5. And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself.

KIDS BIBLE STUDY #23

- 1. Then he said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms must be fulfilled."
- 2. Yes
- 3. Jesus did.
- 4. Repentance and forgiveness of sins (This is salvation, or being 'saved')
- 5. The promise of my Father upon you (This is the Holy Spirit)
- 6. Until they were clothed with power from on high ('power', G1411 in Strong's is 'miraculous power') ¹

KIDS BIBLE STUDY #24

- 1. He told them that Jesus had risen and that He was not there. Then he told them to go tell the disciples that Jesus was going to Galilee and they would see Him, just as He told them.
- 2. Jesus rebuked the disciples for their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they had not believed those who saw Him after He had risen.
- 3. He told them to go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation.
- 4. Saved! and it means 'to heal, protect, deliver, make whole!!'...
- 5. 'Saved' is G4982 in the Strong's Concordance. It means to 'heal, protect, deliver, make whole! 1
- 6. Believers (Christians) will cast out demons; they will speak in new tongues; they will pick up serpents with their hands; if they drink any deadly poison, it will not hurt them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will recover!
- 7. The Lord works with us and confirms the message by accompanying signs.

KIDS BIBLE STUDY #25

- 1. God first revealed the revelation of Christ to Paul. God revealed the revelation of Christ to His people through the Spirit.
- 2. The Gentiles are fellow heirs; members of the same body; partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel.
- 3. To preach to the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ, and to bring to light for everyone what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in God, so that through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places.
- 4. Through the church
- 5. This was according to the eternal purpose that he has realized in Christ Jesus our Lord, in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through our faith in him. (ESV)
- 6. With boldness and confidence

KIDS BIBLE STUDY #26

- 1. That according to the riches of his glory he (God) may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.
- 2. Christ. (You are just like Him, one of God's children. God loves you as much as He loves Jesus.)
- 3. With all the fullness of God.
- 4. God is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us.
- 5. Think. (And we can ask and think for a lot of great things He says!)
- 6. According to the power at work within us

KIDS BIBLE STUDY #27

- 1. Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.
- 2. Yes, He wants you to tell Him what you need and want.
- 3. Yes: in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.
- 4. God wants you to think about whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, things of excellence and worthy of praise. (ESV)
- 5. (God does <u>not</u> want you to ever think bad thoughts, or fearful thoughts, or any thoughts that are not godly. He does **not** want you to watch or listen to anything that He would not like or approve.)
- 6. No! God says in verse 8 that He wants you to only think pure and lovely thoughts.
- 7. God wants you to practice the things that Paul teaches. (Paul wrote many books in the New Covenant, especially Ephesians, Colossians, Philippians, Galatians......)

KIDS BIBLE STUDY #28

- 1. God wants you to pay attention to His Word, the Bible. That is God talking to you and teaching you.
- 2. You are supposed to listen to His Word, and what God is telling you when you read and study it.
- 3. Sight. You must read God's Word every day. Keep it going into your eyes and ears.
- 4. You keep God's Word in your heart by reading your Bible each day, and studying the Bible, and listening to His Word through other ways too.
- 5. God's Words are life to those who find them. (That's you: you read God's Word, so you found it!)
- 6. God's Words are **healing and health to your body.** (So read it a lot!)
- 7. God's Word is healing and health to your body!
- 8. Keep your heart with all vigilance. (This means to not let anything ungodly into your eyes and ears.)

KIDS BIBLE STUDY #29

- 1. Because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be **saved**. (ESV)
- 2. 'Saved', G4982 in Strong's Concordance, means 'heal, protect, deliver, make whole, preserve, save, sozo.' 1 (This word includes a lot of great blessings that are already yours because you are already saved! Everyone who believes that Jesus is their Savior is saved!)
- 3. We believe in our heart. (So keep putting God's Word in your heart every day!)
- 4. You are <u>already</u> justified and saved and a child of God. Everyone who believes Christ is their Savior is saved and justified. God loves <u>you</u> just as much as He loves Jesus. He sent Jesus for you.
- 5. He bestows His riches on all who call on Him. (This means everyone who believes that Jesus is their Savior. That means you! He has already bestowed His riches on you.)

6. <u>Saved</u>! (Always remember that the word '<u>saved</u>', G4982, means to '<u>heal, protect, deliver</u>, make whole, preserve......).¹

KIDS BIBLE STUDY #30

- 1. God sent His Son to be the Savior of the world. (Jesus is your Savior. God sent Him for you. Always remember that God loves you as much as He loves Jesus.)
- 2. God lives and abides in you, and you live and abide in Him.
- 3. God is love. Whoever lives and abides in love, lives and abides in God.
- 4. As He is, so are **you.** In this world, **you** are like Jesus. You are part of God's Family.
- 5. You <u>already</u> have eternal and everlasting life. You are in Christ.
- 6. If you ask anything according to his will he-hears-you. (When you read your Bible, you discover God's will for you. Example: when you read Proverbs 4:20-23, Isaiah Chapter 54, Ephesians, and Colossians, you know that God wants you healthy, safe, doing great, and protected. You also know from reading Ephesians and Colossians that you have the same authority and position as Jesus, and that you have been greatly blessed. So now since you read His Word every day, you know that God only wants good for you, forever, and that He only gives you good things.)
- 7. 1 John 5:15: And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests that we have asked of Him. (In verse 15, God says that you have the requests you have asked of him. Because you have been reading your Bible, you are discovering wonderful blessings that God has given you since you are already saved through Jesus Christ. Now you know better how to pray and what to pray for and about, because you know God's will for you and your family is only for good. Write down many of your promises from God and read them out loud each day. God wants these blessings to show up in your life every day.)
