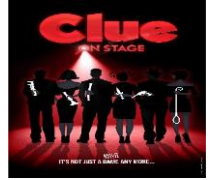




CLUE Audition Instructions



This Fall 2020 season, Pacific Okinawa Players will be producing “CLUE.” Auditions will be held virtually, with actors submitting audition videos to the casting crew. Call-backs will be conducted individually and in-person following the general auditions.

At www.pacificokinawaplayers.org/auditions, you’ll find the list of monologues to choose from. Record yourself performing at least one (no more than three) of the parts you are reading for and save it to a Google Drive (you will need a Gmail address for this). You may either record one video per monologue or record all three monologues at once. Make sure lighting and sound are good enough to see and hear you clearly.

Please ensure you title your videos “LastName_FirstName_Audition_CLUE.” Once uploaded, share your video with popsgetaclue@gmail.com.

You will also need to fill out an audition form, which discusses your information, acting history, and interest in the play. You may print and fill out this form or fill it out electronically. Once finished, send the form to popsgetaclue@gmail.com as an attachment, and let us know that you have also submitted your audition video to us.

Auditions and audition forms are due to popsgetaclue@gmail.com by **9:00am on September 7, 2020**. Auditions submitted after this deadline may not be considered for call-backs.

Actors will receive notifications by email for call-backs by 12:00pm on September 10; this email will also include materials required to prepare (generally, another monologue and at least one cold read). Call-backs will occur on September 12 at a location TBD, and will be individually scheduled with the actor; further coordination can be made over email.
