#### Whose Road Is It Anyway?

In Corotoman By The Bay, our subdivision has 22 roads providing access to 591 lots and some 131 homes. Three of these roads, Corrotoman Drive, Bayview Drive and Marina Road, are maintained by the Commonwealth of Virginia's Department of Transportation (VDOT). One way you can identify state maintained roads is that they have a road number, not just a name.



Along with repairing potholes, this state agency is responsible for snow plowing and ensuring the roads are safe. To report unsafe and hazardous road conditions or if you have a question about maintenance of our state maintained roads, please call VDOT Customer Service at 1-800- 367-7623.

CBTB Association is responsible for snow plowing, graveling and repairing the other 19 roads that are: Club View Drive, Corrotoman Drive Extension, Cove Lane, Dock Road, East Highview Drive, Evergreen Drive, Forest Lane, Landsend East, Landsend West, Meadowview Lane, Middle Road, Pine Place, Ridge Road, Sandy Lane, Senior Creek Place, Sutherland Street, Tiny Place, West Highview Drive and Wishing Well Lane.

To report unsafe and hazardous road conditions for these roads, please send an email to CBT-Bay@gmai.com with the details. James Allen is the volunteer Board member who serves as Chairman of the Roads and Maintenance Committee.

Each spring an assessment of the community-maintained roads is done to prioritize our road maintenance projects. We have strived to keep the costs to a minimum while being safe. With the desire to end CBTB's responsibility for the roads, several years ago the CBTB Board investigated transferring association maintained roads to VDOT. Engineers and professionals from VDOT inspected the association roads, most of which are gravel, and found they needed widening, paving, and larger cul-de-sacs to meet VDOT standards before VDOT will take over responsibility for them.

Since this upgrade would be a considerable cost to the association, the CBTB Board decided not to pursue this project at that time, and instead continue the minimum road maintenance we have been doing. It's a successful road we can keep traveling! We continue to have vandalism done to the community pickleball paddles available at the Tennis/Pickleball courts. The paddles are there for everyone's use and should be taken care of, not destroyed.

As a reminder, basketballs are not permitted at anytime on the tennis/pickleball court. The tennis backboard is not designed for impact from a basketball.
