BISMARCK HIGH: The Demons (14-5-1 Overall; 8-3-1 WDA) captured their third ND state boys' soccer title last week in Mandan, and first since 1997. It was BHS' seventh championship appearance.

For a second day in a row, BHS needed penalty kicks following overtime to win. BHS played to a 1-1 tie through regulation and two overtime periods with Fargo Shanley before winning in penalty kicks, 4-3. Hunter Johnson scored the Demons goal in regulation to force OT. BHS won the shootout (4-3). BHS advanced to the title with a 3-0 victory over G.F. Red River in the quarterfinals. Johnson, Michael Hertz and Brock Muth netted goals. Goalkeeper Derek Wachter made 16 saves in the shutout.

In the semifinals, BHS led Fargo South 1-0 on Hertz's second tournament goal, but the Bruins would tie and force extra time. BHS won the shootout (3-1).

Five players were named to the all-region team. Luke Askew, Sr.; Michael Hertz, Sr.; Hunter Johnson, Sr.; Tresor Mugwaneza, So.; Bryce Nybo, Sr.

CENTURY: The Patriots (8-7-4 Overall; 6-3-3 WDA) ended their season with a pair of losses at the ND state boys' soccer tournament in Mandan. Century, the No. 3 seed from the West Region, fell to Fargo South, 3-0, in the quarterfinals and then lost 2-0 in consolation/loser-out play to G.F. Red River. It was the first time this season Century lost back to back matches by shutout.

Four players were named to the all-region team. Christian Bowlinger, Sr.; Max Cook, Sr.; Nick MacArthur, Sr.; Lucas Mayer, Jr.

JAMESTOWN: The Blue Jays had two players selected to the all-region team. Brady Carlson, Sr.; and Braden Sherfy, Jr.

LEGACY: The Sabers had two players selected to the all-region team. Austin Ellingson, Jr.; and Conor Wright, Jr.

MANDAN: The Braves had one player selected to the all-region team. Dante Berrios, Sr.

MINOT: The Magi (15-2-1 Overall; 11-0-1 WDA) ended their season with a sixth place finish at the ND state boys' soccer tournament in Mandan.

Minot opened with a disappointing 2-1 loss to West Fargo in double overtime in the quarterfinals. Matt Oswalt staked the Magi to a 1-0 lead before West Fargo scored and eventually won the game in extra time. It was the second year in a row the Packers defeated Minot in the quarterfinal round. It was also the first time Minot dropped back-to-back matches this season. The Magi rebounded with a 5-0 win against WDA rival St. Mary's in the consolation/play-in round. Amadu Jalloh scored a pair of goals. Miguel Manriquez, Evan Bolinske and Noah Melby also scored. Goalkeeper Jesse Roberts made six saves to get the shutout. Against GF Red River in the consolation championship, the Magi lost 3-2 in a shootout. Oswalt and Jalloh netted goals to give the Magi a 2-0 lead, but Red River stormed back, eventually winning the game in a penalty kick shootout, 3-1.

Minot scored the first goal in all three tournament matches. Four players were named to the all-region team. J.J. Johannsen, So.; Matthew Oswalt, Sr.; Jesse Roberts, Sr.; Jake Tremble, Sr.

ST. MARY'S: The Saints (5-11-3 Overall; 4-5-3 WDA) ended their season with a pair of losses at the ND state boys' soccer tournament in Mandan. SM dropped its quarterfinal match to Fargo Shanley, 3-0. It then fell to Minot, 5-0, in consolation/loser-out play. SM is winless in its last four state quarterfinal matches. SM was shutout seven times this season.

BISMARCK HIGH: The Demons (11-5-1 Overall; 8-3-1 WDA) are the top seed from the West Region entering this week's ND State Tournament in Mandan. BHS faces GF Red River in a quarterfinal on Thursday, Oct. 15. The Demons defeated the Roughriders, 2-1, earlier this season. BHS last won the state title in 1997.

BHS won last week's West Region Championship, topping Minot, 5-3. The Demons were the first WDA team to defeat Minot, which was the region's top seed. Michael Hertz scored a pair of goals. BHS senior Bryce Nybo was named region senior athlete of the year. Nybo, Hunter Johnson and Michael Hertz were named to the all-tourney team. Earlier in the week, BHS ended its regular season with a 4-1 decision over St. Mary's.

CENTURY: The Patriots (8-5-4 Overall; 6-3-3 WDA) are the No. 3 seed from the West Region entering this week's ND State Tournament in Mandan. Century meets Fargo South in a quarterfinal on Thursday, Oct. 15. Century last won the title in 2013.

Last week, the Patriots defeated Mandan, 4-0, in a state qualifying match. Century has reached the state tournament for a 21st straight season. Four different players scored, Max Cook, Christian Bowlinger, Zach Jensen, Lucas Mayer.

Bowlinger, Tyler Hoggarth and Jensen were named to the all-tourney team.

Earlier in the week, the Patriots wrapped up its regular season with a 2-0 loss to WDA champion Minot.

JAMESTOWN: The Blue Jays (6-8-3 Overall; 5-5-2 WDA) ended its season with a tough 1-0 loss to St. Mary's in a state qualifying match at the West Region Tournament in Mandan last week. Jamestown was bidding for its first state tournament appearance since 2008. Justin Briss, Brady Carlson and Christopher Hare were named to the all-tourney team.

Earlier in the week, the Blue Jays ended the regular season by rallying for a 2-2 tie with visiting Legacy. Beau Waldo and Braden Sherfy netted goals for the Blue Jays.

LEGACY: The Sabers (2-12-3 Overall; 0-9-3 WDA) ended their season with a 3-1 loss to Mandan in the West Region play-in match last week. It was the second year in a row Legacy lost to Mandan in the play-in. Donovan Clark's goal early in the second half tied the score. Mandan and Legacy had tied their two regular season matches.

Austin Ellingson, Connor Wright and Nick Janes were named to the all-tourney team.

Earlier in the week, Legacy secured a sixth place finish in the WDA with a 2-2 tie in the regular season finale at Jamestown. Austin Ellingson scored both goals for Legacy.

MANDAN: The Braves (1-15-3 Overall; 0-9-3 WDA) ended their season with a 4-0 loss to Century in a state qualifying match at the West Region Tournament in Mandan. Goal-keeper Carlos Gomez kept Mandan in the match earlier before Century netted three in the second half to pull away. Mandan advanced to the state qualifier by picking up its first victory of the season, a 3-1 triumph over Legacy. The teams had tied its two regular season matches. Daniel Sanchez, Isaac Fleck and Evan Arenz netted the goals. The three tallies was a season high. Dante Berrios, Ryan Larson and Sanchez were named to the all-tourney team.

MINOT: The Magi (15-2-1 Overall; 11-0-1 WDA) are the No. 2 seed from the West Region entering this week's ND State Tournament in Mandan. Minot hosts West Fargo in a quarterfinal on Thursday, Oct. 15. Minot's lone title came in 2006.

Last week, the Magi fell to BHS, 5-3, in the West Region Championship. The loss snapped Minot's 15-match winning streak and was its first against a conference foe this season. The five goals allowed was also a season high. Avery Weishaar scored a pair of goals. Noah Melby added another tally. Matthew Oswalt, Jesse Roberts and Weishaar were named to the all-tourney team. Creighton Bachmeier was named region coach of the year. Earlier in the week, Minot finished its regular season with a 2-0 shutout over Century. It marked the first time in program history the Magi went unbeaten in WDA regular season play.

ST. MARY'S: The Saints (5-9-3 Overall; 4-5-3 WDA) are the No. 4 seed from the West Region entering this week's ND State Tournament in Mandan. SM will take on East Region's top seed, Fargo Shanley, in a Thursday, Oct. 15 quarterfinal. SM has dropped two matches to the Deacons this season. SM has never won a state title.

Last week, SM qualified with a 1-0 win over Jamestown in a state qualifier at the West Region Tournament in Mandan. James Schmidt's tally in the 24th minute stood up, giving SM its eighth straight trip to the state tournament. Steven Hutzenbiler, Schmidt and Adam Thorson were named to the all-tourney team.

Earlier last week, the Saints lost its regular season finale to BHS, 4-1, to finish fifth in the conference.

BISMARCK HIGH: The Demons (9-5-1 Overall; 7-3-1 WDA) wrap up WDA regular season play on Tuesday, Oct. 6 when it faces St. Mary's. A win, coupled with a Century loss or tie to Minot, would clinch the W. Region second seed for BHS and an automatic berth into the region title match on Saturday, Oct. 10 in Mandan as well as a spot in next week's state tournament. BHS has qualified for all 20 previous NDHSAA-sponsored state tournaments.

Last week, the Demons split two matches, defeating Jamestown, 2-0, and falling to rival Century, 2-1. Senior Hunter Johnson scored goals in both matches, extending his consecutive match scoring streak to eight.

CENTURY: The Patriots (7-4-4 Overall; 6-2-3 WDA) can clinch the W. Region second seed with a win in its final regular season match on Tuesday, Oct. 6 against WDA champion Minot. Century still could clinch second with a loss or tie, if BHS loses or ties its last match. A second placed finish gives Century a berth into the region title match on Saturday, Oct. 10 and a spot in next week's state tournament. Century has finished second or first in each of the past eight seasons and has qualified for all 20 NDHSAA-sponsored state tournaments.

Last week, Century downed Legacy, 4-0, and then edged rival BHS, 2-1. Against Legacy, Lucas Mayer netted his second hat trick of the season. Against the Demons, Mayer's goal in at the 20th min. of the first half proved to be the game winner. Max Cook also scored. Century is now 6-0-1 when it has the lead at halftime.

JAMESTOWN: The Blue Jays (6-7-2 Overall; 5-5-1 WDA) wrap up their regular season on Tuesday, Oct. 6 at home against Legacy. A win coupled with a St. Mary's loss or tie would give the Blue Jays the fourth seed in this week's W. Region Tournament. It's possible the squad could still finish fourth even with a loss. The Blue Jays last qualified for the state tournament in 2008.

Last week, Jamestown split two matches, falling to BHS, 2-0, before topping Mandan, 4-0. Beau Waldo and Chris Hare each netted two goals in the win over the Braves.

LEGACY: The Sabers (2-11-2 Overall; 0-9-2 WDA) will finish the regular season on Tuesday, Oct. 6 at Jamestown. The Sabers have a chance to finish with the W. Region's sixth seed with at least one point. Legacy will be playing in a region play-in contest with Mandan on Thursday, Oct. 10. The winner advances to a state qualifying match. Last year, the Sabers lost to Mandan in the region play-in.

Last week, the Sabers were shutout, 4-0, to Century and 2-0 to WDA champion Minot.
