#### RULES OF CONDUCT FOR PADDOCK RIDING CLUB

These are the rules that govern your use of the Paddock Riding Club ("PRC") stables and riding facilities (the "Paddock"). Failure to comply with them is grounds for termination of your right to use the Paddock.

1. Keep dogs on leash and under control at all times.
2. Wear appropriate foot covering.
3. Horses in arenas must be accompanied by a capable handler.
4. Do not turn any horse loose anywhere in the Paddock except in designated areas.
5. Do not leave any horse unattended anywhere in the Paddock except in its stall.
6. Do not tie any horse to any fence, stall, or other structure or fixture except designated cross tie areas.
7. Clean up after your horse in all areas outside its stall. Place all trash, litter, droppings, and garbage in appropriate receptacle.
8. Wash your horse only in wash area. Remove all manure, hair, and other debris from wash rack and place in receptacle provided before departing with horse. Do not let manure, hair, or other debris enter drain, which is for liquids only.
9. Keep all tack in tack rooms when not in use.
10. Safeguard all personal property, including articles in vehicles, lockers, tack rooms, and other facilities. PRC is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage.
11. Only Owners, trainers, instructors, and clients of trainers or instructors during training or instruction time may use the riding facilities.
12. Have your guests obtain, sign, and deliver PRC's release form. You are solely responsible for the conduct and safety of your guests.
13. Ride your horse at a walk in stable areas.
14. Keep your horse on a lead rope and tied or held by another person when being groomed, tacked up, or otherwise handled without rider outside of stall.
15. Direct all requests and complaints to PRC management. Do not give instructions to or criticize stable hands or other personnel directly.
16. Stallions must be handled only by persons over 18 years old who have been properly trained in their handling.
17. Do not enter any ring or arena that has been reserved or prepared for a lesson or show. Rings and arenas that are prepared for lessons or shows are not available for general riding.
18. Do not enter or use a ring that is being watered or on which other maintenance is being performed.
19. Do not smoke in the barns or in any other area where "no smoking" signs are posted.
20. Do not leave any horse in any outside paddock for more than one hour.
21. Close your horse's stall doors (including feeder doors) when the stall is not in use. Alternatively, you may obtain PRC's approval to install a second gate or door approved by PRC.
22. Keep any feed you have at the Paddock in a proper, tight-lidded container only in the location designated for Owner feed. Do not use PRC's feed, even to feed your own horse; only PRC employees may use PRC's feed
23. Do not bring any horse to the Paddock except the horse that is named in your contract with PRC.
24. Do not store any trailer at the Paddock without PRC's prior written consent and payment of required fees. If you are permitted to store a trailer, store it securely in the designated location.
25. Do not cross tie horses in the aisles.
26. Riders who choose not to wear protective head gear do so contrary to PRC's recommendation and at their own risk.
27. Only qualified riders wearing protective head gear may use jumps. Jumpers must be under the supervisions of an approved instructor. Do not move or modify jumps; jumps may be moved or modified only by a qualified instructor.
28. Children under 16 may not be on Paddock grounds unless accompanied and supervised by a responsible person over 20 years old.
29. Children may not run or play in stables, arenas, rings, or any riding area.
30. Lessons have priority right to use of rings. Practice and pleasure riders must defer to lessons.
31. Paddock hours are 6 AM to 10 PM, subject to change upon notice. Do not enter the Paddock at any time other than during those hours.
