FOOTBALL TIDBITS

LSU has scored at least 40 points in 3 straight games vs AP Top-10 opponents. That is tied for the longest streak by a SEC team in the AP Poll Era (since 1936). Florida did it in 2007-2008

Baylor has started 6-0 for the 5th time this decade (2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2019). That's the 4th-most instances by any FBS school, trailing Clemson, Alabama and Ohio State (7 each). Baylor QB Charlie Brewer had 3 Rush TD in their overtime win over Texas Tech, tied for the most by a QB in school history.

Florida State has been outscored by 80 points in its last 2 games vs Clemson. That is the Seminoles' worst point differential over a 2-game span vs a single opponent in school history. The previous worst was -78 vs Florida in 1972 and 1973.

Wisconsin is the 1st FBS team to record 4 shutouts in its 1st 6 games of a season since Oklahoma in 1967. They're also the 1st Big Ten team to do this since Minnesota in 1962. The Badgers' 29 points allowed are the fewest through 6 games by any FBS team since 1993 (Florida State).

For a 2nd consecutive season, Tua Tagovailoa threw his first pick of the season after tossing 26 touchdown passes. Only Louisiana Tech's Colby Cameron had thrown more TD passes before his first pick among FBS quarterbacks the last 20 seasons.

South Carolina closed as 21-point underdog (according to Caesars Sportsbook) making its win at #3 Georgia the largest upset in an SEC game since 2014 when Texas A&M took down #3 Auburn

Georgia now has just 3 home losses as an AP Top-3 team in the AP Poll Era (since 1936), but the first two of those had come against ranked opponents. This past Saturday was the first time a Top-3 ranked Georgia squad had lost at Sanford Stadium to an unranked opponent.

MICHIGAN AT PENN STATE



Michigan (5-1) travels to Happy Valley to take on Penn State (6-0) in a huge Big Ten East Division game. Kickoff is at 7:30 PM EDT and the game will be nationally televised on ABC.

The big question is which Michigan team will show up? Most agree that Michigan has a pretty talented roster and playmakers but for what ever reason, they occasionally come out flat or slow. QB Shea Patterson has shown flashes of greatness at times and has looked average at other times. He must be on his game if Michigan wants to leave with a victory. RB's Hassen Haskins & Zach Charbonnet are going to be important as well.

QB Sean Clifford looks like the real deal for James Franklin's squad. He can pass effectively but he also has the ability to pull it down and run for a first down when they need it. Noah Cain has taken over as the primary Penn State running back the past couple of weeks so expect to see him a lot on Saturday night.

This is a fairly young series. The first time these two traditional powers met on the gridiron was in 1993 (Penn State's first year as a member of the Big Ten). Michigan leads the all-time series with Penn State 14-8. At Beaver Stadium Michigan leads 6-5. Last year in Ann Arbor, Michigan pummeled Penn State 42-7. This is a really tough game to predict but we're going to go with the home team. Penn State 28, Michigan 24.
