PSA MINI Tournament

June 29, 2019

The first Mini Tournament for the 2019 fishing season was a challenge for hardy PSA members taking on the Big Lake.

A nice number of boats, 11 total, had a beautiful day on the water, with fishing on the 'tough' side. PSA added \$100 to the total prize money, and with the 11 boats paying the \$10 entry fee, the total prize to be divided among the winners was \$210.

Results: Big Fish, winning 50% of the prize total, was Mike Havens, Big Foot Boat, with a 24.65 # King Salmon.

Most Fish, winning 30% of the win package was Steve Sauser, Fish Eagle Boat, with a total of 5 fish.

Mystery Weight of 8 pounds, winning 20% of the package, was Dean Jessup, Dean's Dream Boat, with an 8.2# Steelhead.

There were a total of 20 fish boated, weighing 160.7 pounds. Breakdown was: King Salmon, 14 fish with total weight of 128.1#, Lake Trout, 4 fish with total weight of 19.3#, Steelhead, 1 fish weighing 8.2#, and a Coho weighing 6.1#. Plus, the coho was added to the PSA Annual Big Fish Contest.

PENTWATER SPORTFISHING ASSOCIATION MEETING - June 15th, 2019

PENTWATER FRIENDSHIP CENTER

Directors Present: Dean Jessup, Patsy Gettings, Dan Gettings, and Brad Smith. Excused, Rob Bannink because of work schedule and George Cornell.

Meeting called to order at 3:05 p.m. by President Dean Jessup. With 4 directors present, we did have a quorum.

- A. The Meeting Minutes, from the May 18, 2019, were reviewed with no questions or revisions. Moved to approve by Patsy G, supported by Brad. Motion carried.
- B. Treasurer's Report: Patsy Gettings handed out report and went over it in detail. PSA has a strong checkbook balance after the Memorial Weekend Derby, from good profit on raffle ticket sales, and clothing sales. Brad moved, supported by Dan, to accept Treasurer's Report as presented Motion carried.
- C. Membership Update. Current paid membership is lagging behind 2018, with just 48 paid members to date. Total for 2018 was 81. Discussion followed with Brad making suggestion to contact members that have not renewed membership. Brad and Dean will set up a program for contact.
- D. Committee Reports:
 - 1. Clothing Dan Gettings Good Derby sales of \$485. We still have good inventory for the remainder of this season.
 - 2. Channel Lights Dean with high water, most brackets are now under water and not able to be used. The light at private pier on inside channel, south side, has been placed.
 - 3. Newsletter Dean talked with Kristy computer problem is being fixed with hopes of newsletters getting back out soon.
 - 4. Ladies Classic Patsy will confer with Lyn on needs.
 - 5. Bannink Lines Down No report
 - The first announcement for the Teach A Kid event has been sent via e-mail to all PSA members. Date set for July 13. Contact Dean to get your boat / team registered.
 - 7. Dean reported that the Annual Big Fish contest is up and running.

PSA MEETING MINUTES CONTINUED – June 15th, 2019

New Business:

- A. The matching fund program for the Village Fish Cleaning Station during Derby time was a giant success. With the PSA match of \$250, PSA will donate \$1000 to the Village at the next Village Council Meeting. Thank you PSA members for your contribution to this important fixture in Pentwater.
- B. Earlier this day (June 15), the First Annual Kids Water Safety Day, set up by Marine Officer Tim Simon, was a large success. PSA supported this effort, which allowed the free distribution of 90-life vest to kids along with the Oceana Sheriff's office cooking over 400 hotdogs. Interactive displays were available for kids from Oceana County Sheriff Department, MI DNR Conservation Officers, Pentwater Village Police, Pentwater Village Fire Department, and U.S. Coast Guard.
- C. Dean noted the Mini Tournament is set for June 29. After discussion on how we could help promote this event, Dan move, with support from Brad, to increase the PSA donations to the Mini Tournaments to \$100 for this year. Motion carried. Registration will remain at \$10 / boat, and the % split will also remain.
- D. Dean led discussion of MD Derby review.
 - Pasty presented a detailed / itemized report for all income including: 39 boats registered, 24 boats entered the 50/50 Challenge, collected \$375 in memberships, sold 651 raffle tickets, and had \$485 in clothing sales. A special 'THANK YOU' to Amy Sharp for assisting Patsy on covering all the registration items.
 - 2. Dan coordinated the weigh-in schedule to insure all times were covered.
 - Dean noted main sponsor 'Thank You's' have been sent and Bruce K and Dean are working on the local consolation prize donation Thank You's

Meeting was adjourned at 4:10 p.m.
