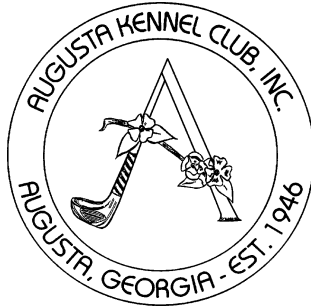

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors to set up after 12:00 NOON on Friday. **No dogs allowed to be left overnight.** All dogs must be removed from the show site by 7:30 pm Friday.

BUILDING WILL OPEN AT 7:00 AM, SATURDAY & SUNDAY. DOGS MAY NOT BE LEFT OVERNIGHT IN THE BUILDING. DOGS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE EVENT SITE 30 MINUTES AFTER BEST IN SHOW JUDGING ON SATURDAY & SUNDAY. NO EXCEPTIONS.

NO DOG WASHING FACILITIES ARE AVAILABLE AT SHOW SITE.

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS!

Single vehicles limited to single parking space.

No Grooming Tables or Ex-Pens in Parking Spaces.

No Parking in loading zones, except to load and unload only. UNATTENDED VEHICLES PARKED IN RESTRICTED AREAS AND LOADING ZONES WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

Ex-pens may be setup on grassy areas. Public exercise areas will be marked. No ex-pens in event building.

Aisleways & doors must not be blocked in the ring and grooming areas by order of the Fire Marshal.

Ringside crating in designated areas during breed judging must be removed following breed judging.

No dogs allowed in restrooms.

No training or prong collars on show grounds.

Absolutely NO Smoking in the building.

All cell phones, pagers and other electronic equipment must be turned off while ringside and in the ring.

All persons attending these dog events hereby waive any claim for damages against the Augusta Kennel Club, Inc. or its members in the event a motor vehicle has to be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions.

Compliance with directives from security and/or safety/grounds committee members is required at all times.

The show-giving club, the show superintendent, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under control of their parents or guardians.

NO PUPPIES UNDER THE AGE OF SIX (6) MONTHS OF AGE, EXCEPT THOSE ENTERED IN THE 4-6 MONTH PUPPY COMPETITION OR THE FRIDAY MATCH, MAY BE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.

Best in Show, Groups & Best Junior Handler Trophies will be presented in the ring. All other winners will be given a card; the owner or agent can claim the trophy at the trophy table. All trophies must be claimed the day of the events, none will be mailed. The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

A Judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp). Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed. In an emergency situation an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

The following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp: Lagotto Romagnolo, American Water Spaniels, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Cirneco dell'Etna, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Keeshonden, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs and Norrbottenspets (Misc).

The following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Boykin Spaniels and Whippets.

The following breed may be judged on a ramp or on a table: Mudi

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei and Chow Chows.

NEW EXHIBITOR BRIEFING on Saturday. Check Judging Program for time & location.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 1st Entry & \$3.00 additional entry of same dog will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.

RETURNED CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Superintendent will add a fee for completing the transaction and/or reprocessing the entries. Repeated occurrences from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

The show giving Club, the Show Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$3.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.

An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

EXHIBITORS NOTE: Please notify Superintendent of any change of address.

FAX/EMAIL ENTRIES AND PAPER ENTRIES WITH CREDIT CARD ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE METHODS FOR ENTRIES AND WILL NOT BE PROCESSED. **Online Entries and Checks by Mail are not affected by this change.** If mailing be sure to have the entry with check enclosed arrive prior to the closing date of the show. 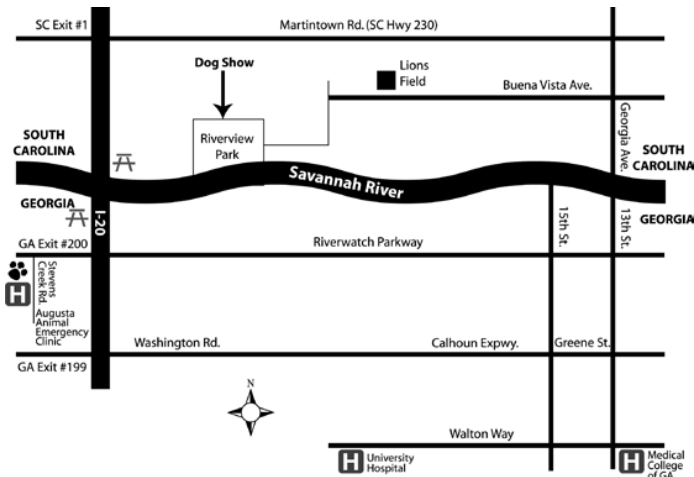

Directions to the Event Site

Coming from South Carolina - Take I-20 West to Exit #1. This is SC Hwy. 230/Martintown Rd. After exiting, turn left & go over I-20. Go approximately 2½ miles to the 5th traffic light. This will be Georgia Ave. Turn right. Go to the 2nd traffic light & turn right on Buena Vista Ave. (Wells Fargo Bank will be on the right hand corner of the intersection.) Buena Vista takes you to Riverview Park. You will pass a football stadium on the right. Continue past Lion's Field around a curve & to a stop sign. Turn left at the stop sign. This will take you to Riverview Park. The Activities Center is on the left.

Coming from Georgia - Take I-20 East to Exit 200, Riverwatch Pkwy. (Riverwatch is the last exit in Georgia, before crossing into SC). Turn left off the exit ramp onto Riverwatch. Riverwatch Pkwy ends when you enter downtown, & becomes Jones St. Go to the 2nd traffic light & turn left on 13th St. (4.7 miles from Exit 200). 13th St will cross the Savannah River into SC & becomes Georgia Ave. Go to the second traffic light & turn left on Buena Vista Ave. (Wells Fargo Bank will be on the left corner of the intersection). Buena Vista takes you to Riverview Park. You will pass a football stadium on the right. Continue past Lion's Field around a curve & to a stop sign. Turn left at the stop sign. This will take you to Riverview Park. The Activities Center is on the left.

SATURDAY & SUNDAY Beginner Puppies (4-6 months of age) AKC Sanctioned Beginner Puppy Competition!

Section 1 - Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for all entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.

- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*

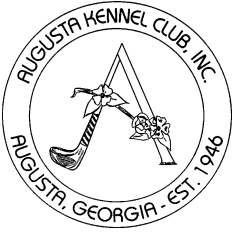
